

## **WATER REPORT – November 1, 2022**

The 1906-priority of Jackson Lake and 1909-priority of Lake Walcott have been very slowly accruing new storage to their accounts over the past two weeks. Henrys Lake (1917), Island Park (1921), Palisades Winter-Water-Savings (1921), and American Falls Reservoir (1921) storage rights will now come into priority and begin accruing storage for next year now that the senior-priority irrigation diversions have reached the end of their decreed period-of-use and have all curtailed.

All canal diversions above American Falls should have ceased before today unless they have in-priority decreed stock water rights, in-priority decreed subirrigation water rights, or they have leased Rental Pool storage allowing them to divert water in November. Any managed groundwater recharge occurring upstream from Minidoka Dam in November this year requires a completed 2022 Rental Pool lease approved by the Watermaster.

Total system natural flow and reservoir system storage at the end of this year are currently at near-record low levels. It will take above-average rainfall and above average snow accumulation from this point forward to have a chance to completely fill the reservoir system for next year. The reservoir system is currently only 17% full compared to being 20% full on this same date last year.

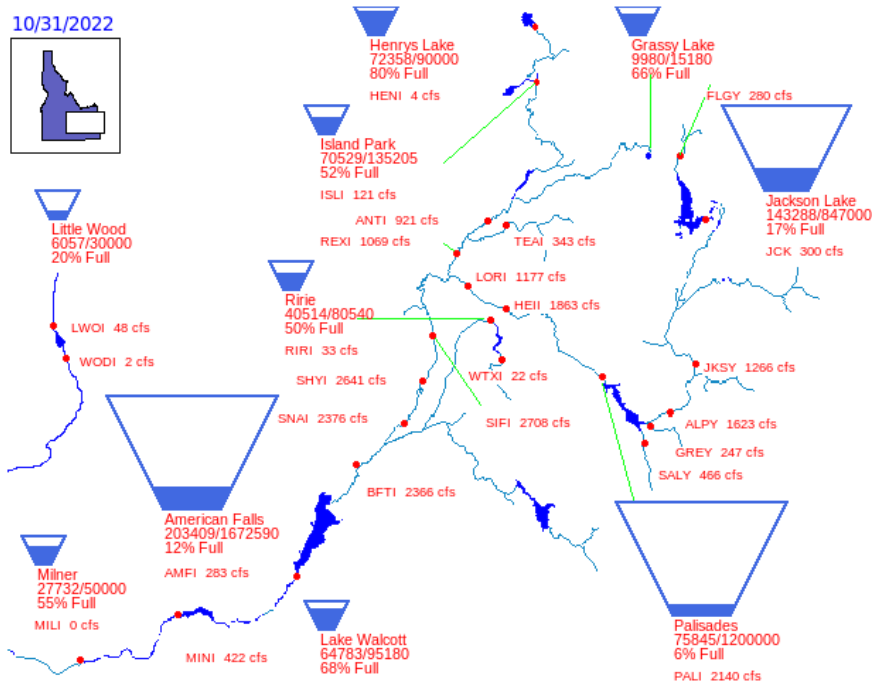
