

Water District 1 Report – July 8th, 2025

A precipitation event occurred on July 4th, bookended by hot, dry weather both before and after. Natural flow on the Snake River above Blackfoot has continued its downward trend, with a slight uptick in response to the precipitation. The precipitation event had a more significant impact on diversion demand above Blackfoot, where diversions dropped by approximately 1,500 cfs. This decrease may also be partially attributed to crop maturity.

Water right priorities are currently split at Blackfoot and are expected to remain so for the rest of the irrigation season. Priorities above Blackfoot continue to decline, with the current projection at **1892-07-29**. Below Blackfoot, the projected priority remains at **1900-10-11**, which is the most senior right available in that reach and is expected to hold through the remainder of the season.

An analysis of comparable years has been compiled to support natural flow and priority projections. Similar years for conditions **above Blackfoot** include **2013**, **2015**, and **2016**, while **2021** and **2012** are considered comparable for conditions **below Blackfoot**. A printed comparison of 2025 to 2013 (above Blackfoot) and 2021 (below Blackfoot) is attached to this report.

Storage allocations have now been incorporated into the "Storage Remaining" column in the daily water right accounting. Canal managers are encouraged to closely monitor:

- Current water right priorities
- Remaining storage supplies
- Diversion operations

Doing so will support efficient water use and help avoid early curtailments. Any canal attempting to divert storage water after exhausting its allocation will be curtailed.

Distributions from the 2024 Common Pool will be issued shortly. Proceeds will be paid pro rata based on space held, and no reduction to 2025 storage allocations was applied for 2024 Common Pool rentals.

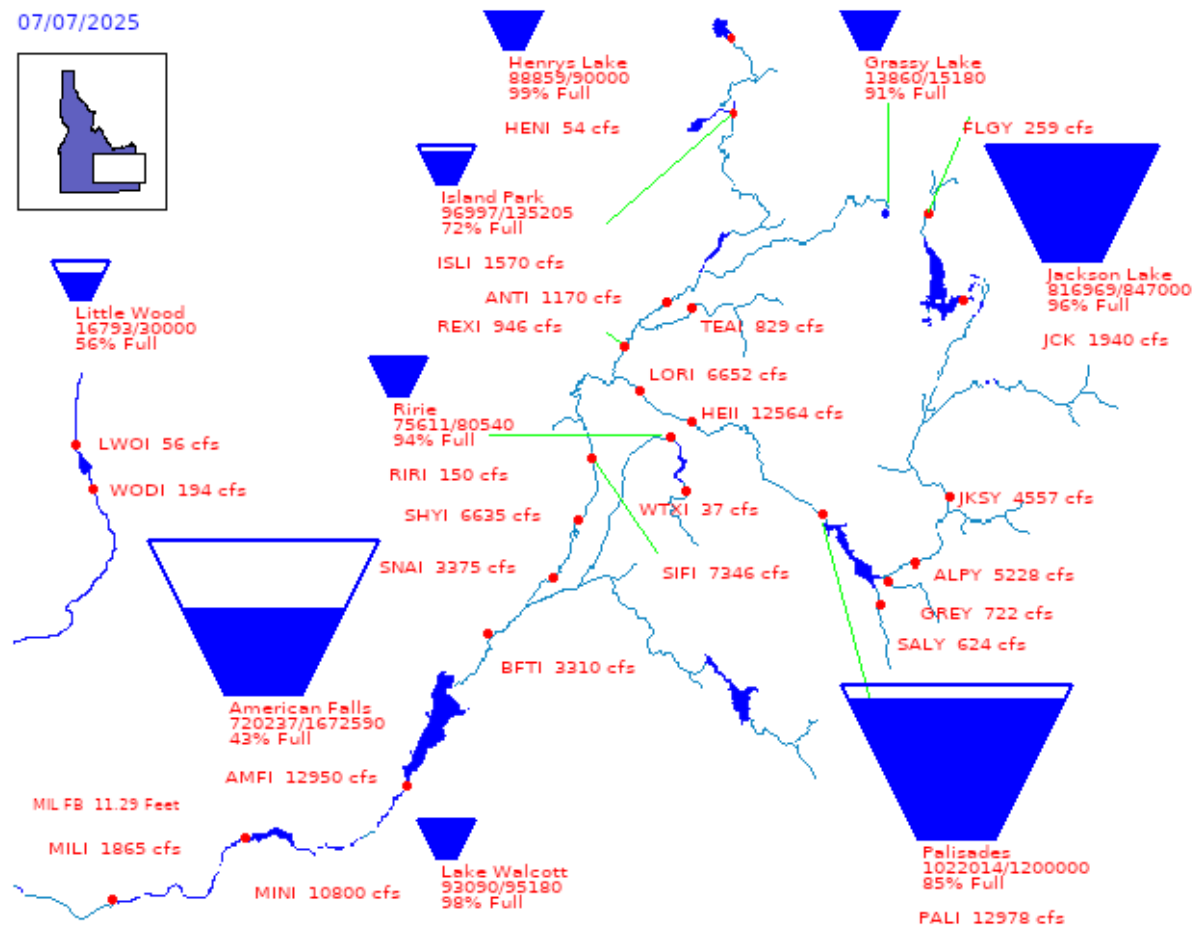
2025 Flow Augmentation releases below Milner have concluded. Flows at Milner have now transitioned to Idaho Power's storage delivery. The flow rate has been reduced from 2,700 cfs to 1,500 cfs, with releases expected to continue until Idaho Power's allocation is fully delivered — currently estimated around July 22.

Canal managers above Blackfoot are encouraged to coordinate with USBR or Water District 1 at 208-525-7161 regarding any anticipated changes in diversion rates, as river operations are being actively managed to maximize upstream storage while maintaining a fully connected Snake River system.

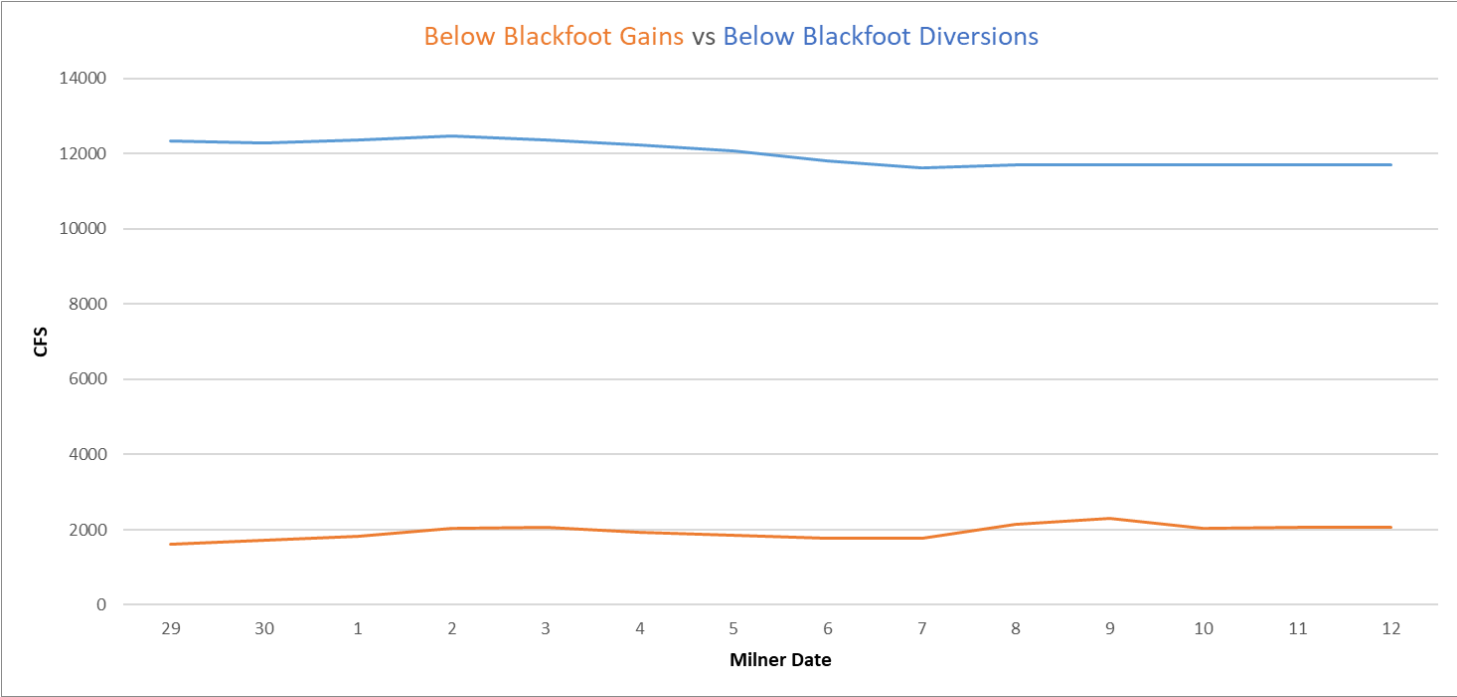
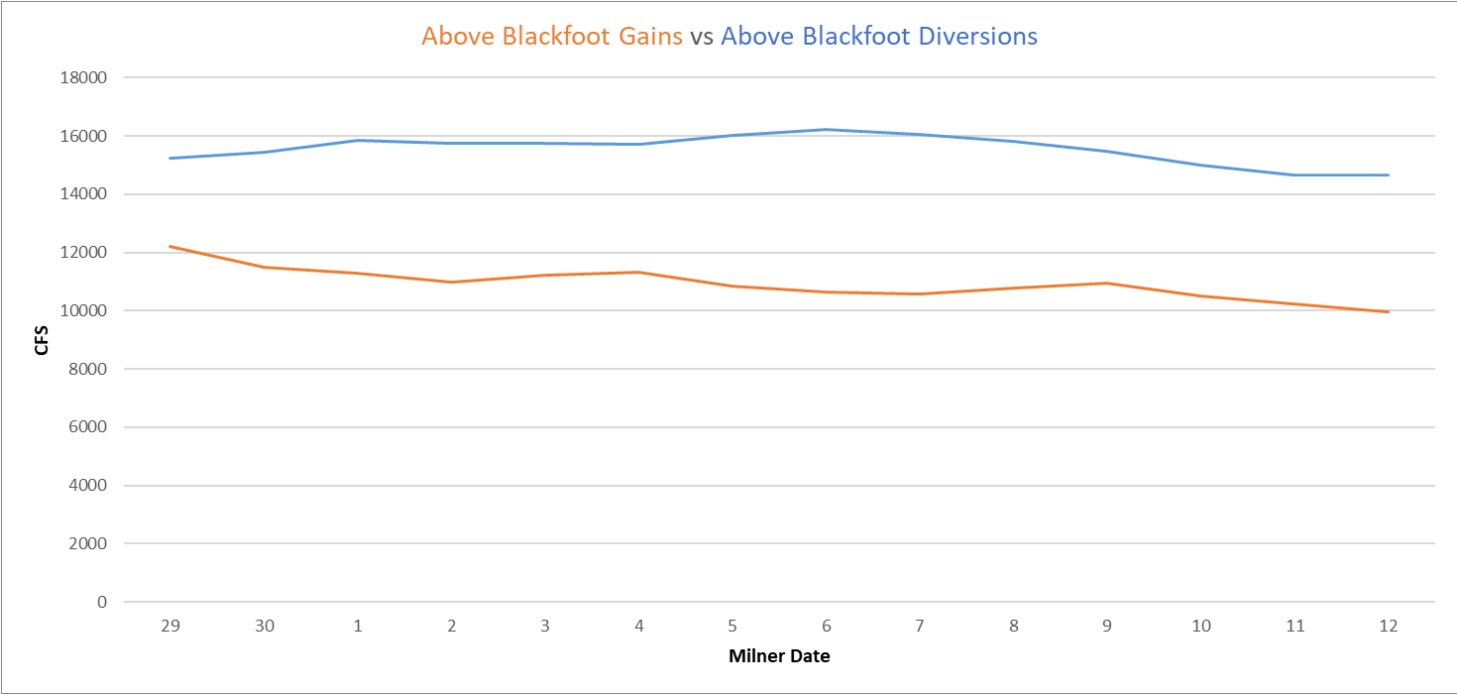
