

Water District 1 Report – July 16th, 2025

Water right priorities are currently split at three key locations: the Snake River at Blackfoot, the Teton River, and Willow Creek. Senior priority rights upstream of Blackfoot and on the Teton and Willow Creek are diverting natural flow available within their respective watersheds. These conditions are expected to continue through the remainder of the irrigation season unless significant precipitation occurs.

Snake River – Upstream of Blackfoot

Over the past week, diversion demand decreased by approximately 650 cfs, while natural flow decreased by about 700 cfs. Natural flow is currently estimated at 8,100 cfs, compared to a diversion demand of roughly 14,000 cfs. The current partially deliverable water right priority is **1890-06-10**.

Flow and priority trends this year resemble those observed in 2013, 2015, and 2016, which were challenging years with natural supply ranking near the 10th percentile of the 30-year median (see attached graphic). During those years, the deliverable water right priority generally hovered between 1889 and 1890 for several weeks.

Snake River – Downstream of Blackfoot

Natural flow has fluctuated between 1,600 and 2,000 cfs, remaining near the 30-year median (see attached graphic). Reach gains below Blackfoot are following a trend similar to 2021. Current diversion demand remains steady at 11,600 cfs, and the partially deliverable water right priority is **1900-10-11**.

Teton River

Conditions on the Teton River have been relatively stable. Natural flow is approximately 550 cfs, with diversion demand around 850 cfs. The deliverable priority on the Teton is currently **1885-06-01**.

Flow Augmentation and Storage Releases

Flow augmentation below Milner concluded on July 7, with a total of 150,000 acre-feet from the common pool and 20,532 acre-feet of uncontracted storage delivered.

Immediately following, Idaho Power began diverting its storage allocation at a rate of 1,500 cfs, which is projected to continue until July 22, when the allocation is expected to be fully utilized.

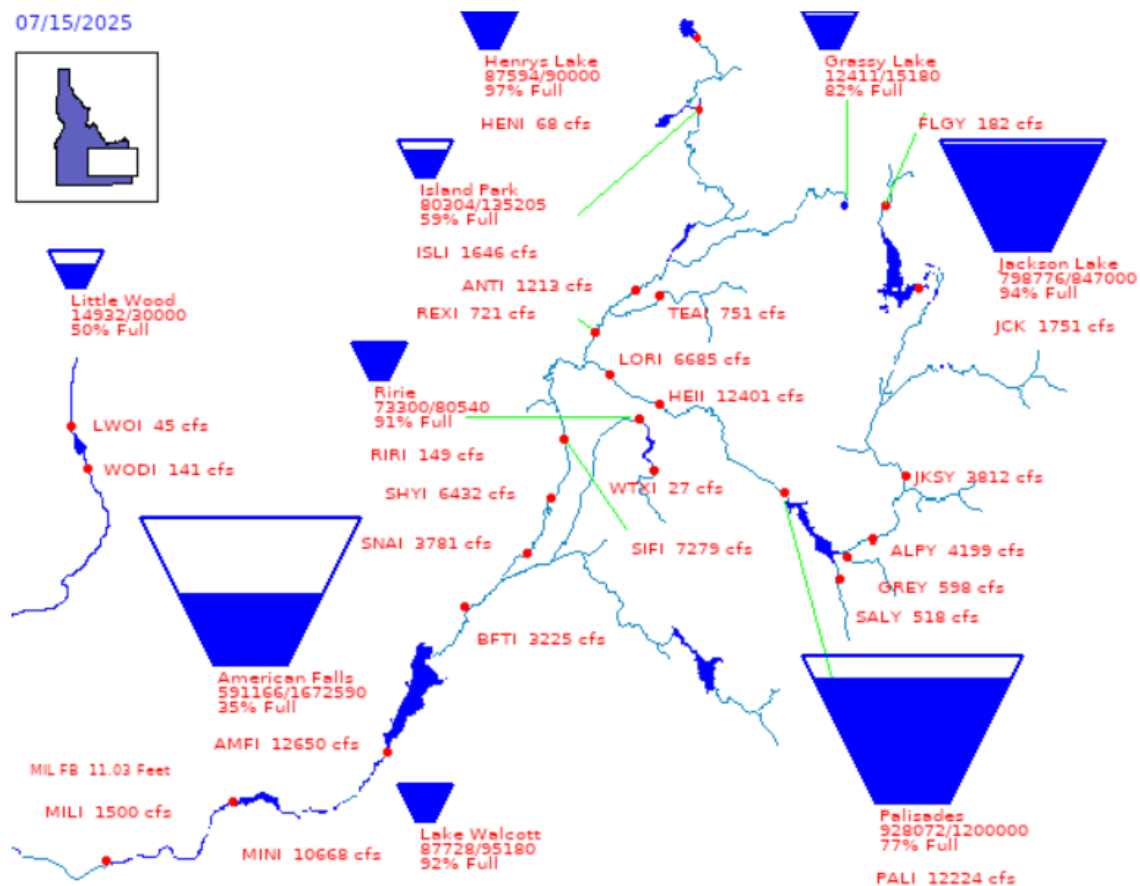

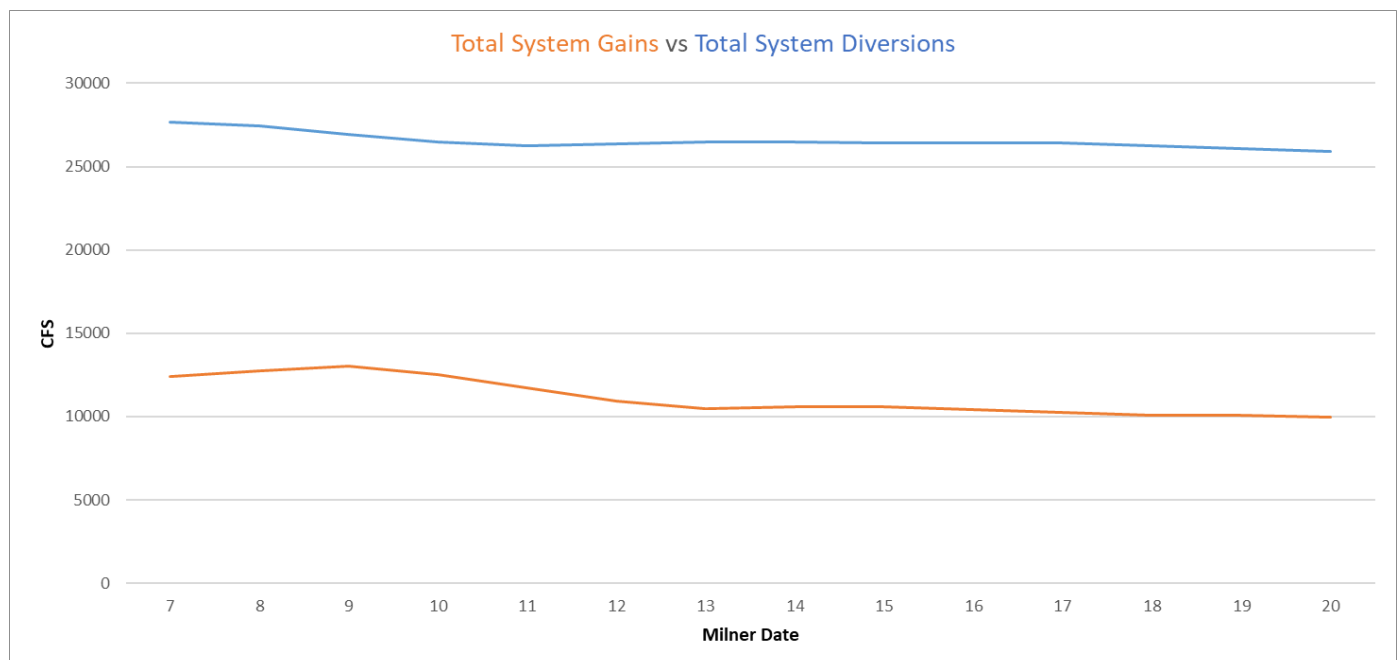

Major Storage Reservoirs in the Upper Snake River Basin

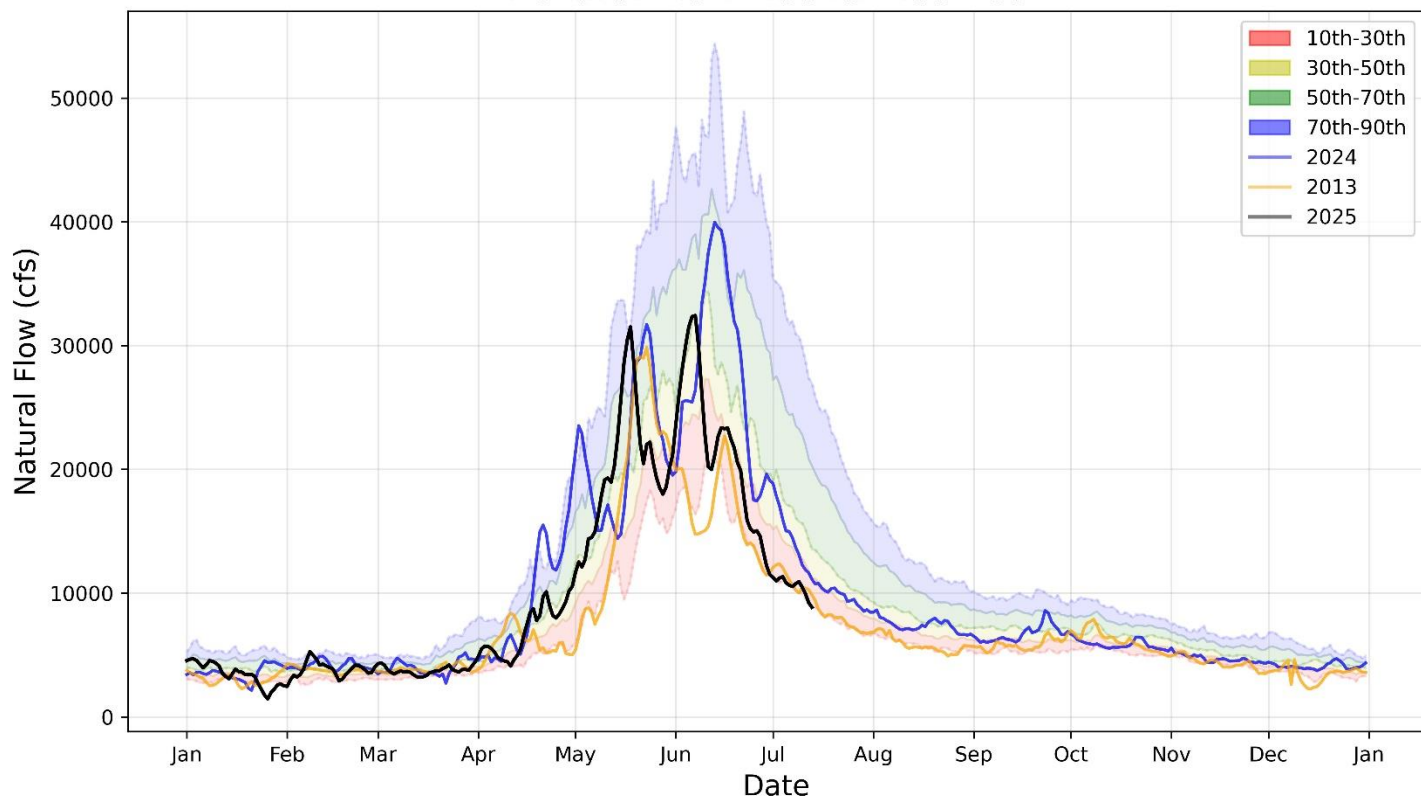

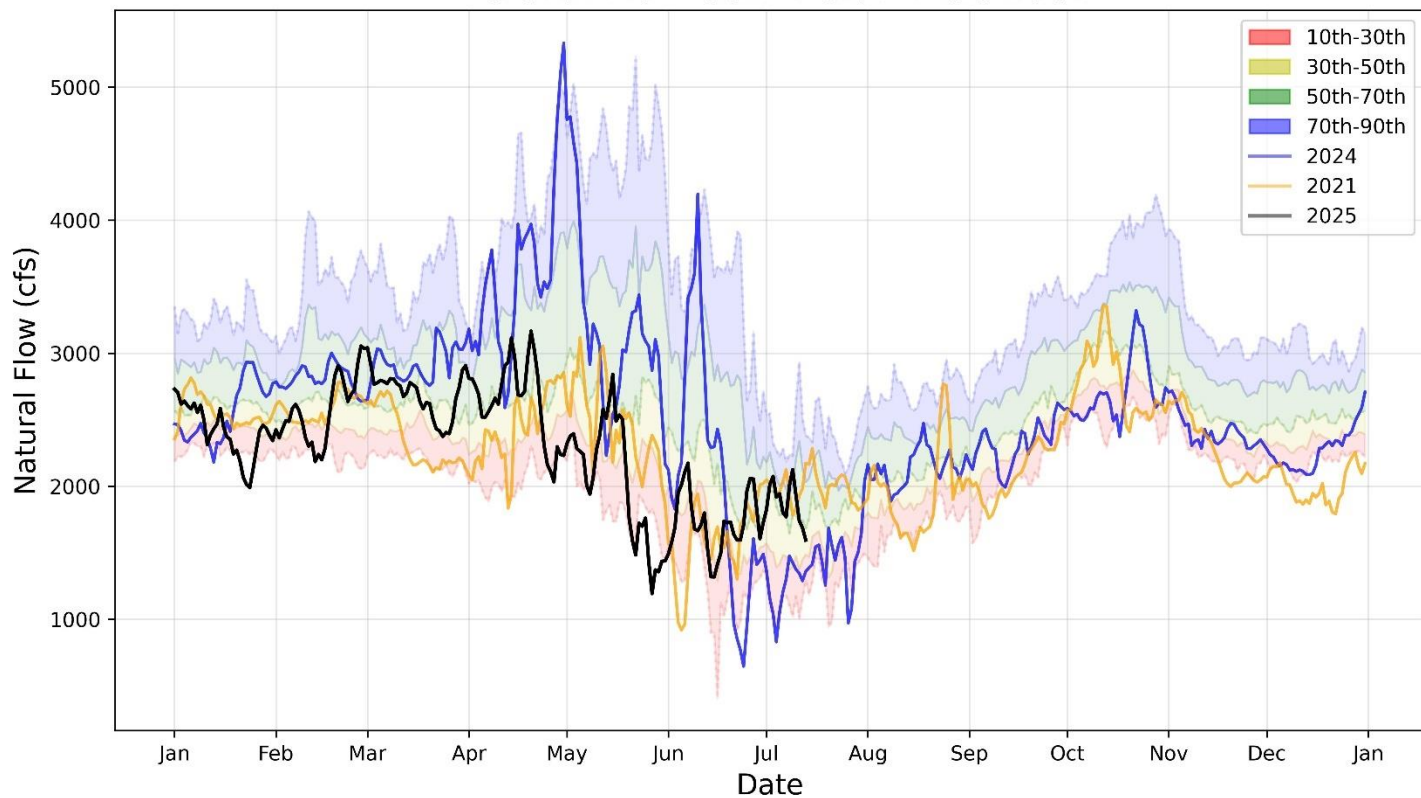
