

Water District 1 Report – August 13th, 2025

The trend in water right priorities continues to follow the typical seasonal pattern, with natural flow supply now largely dependent on base flows. With no significant precipitation over the past week, natural flow supply is steadily declining. Diversions are also decreasing in response to the reduced natural flow and current harvest activity.

Water right priorities on the Snake River above Blackfoot are generally hovering around the 1889 date and are expected to remain there for the next several weeks. The Snake River remains split in priority at Lorenzo, with a slightly lower priority deliverable upstream of Lorenzo.

We are projecting a partial fill of the following water rights:

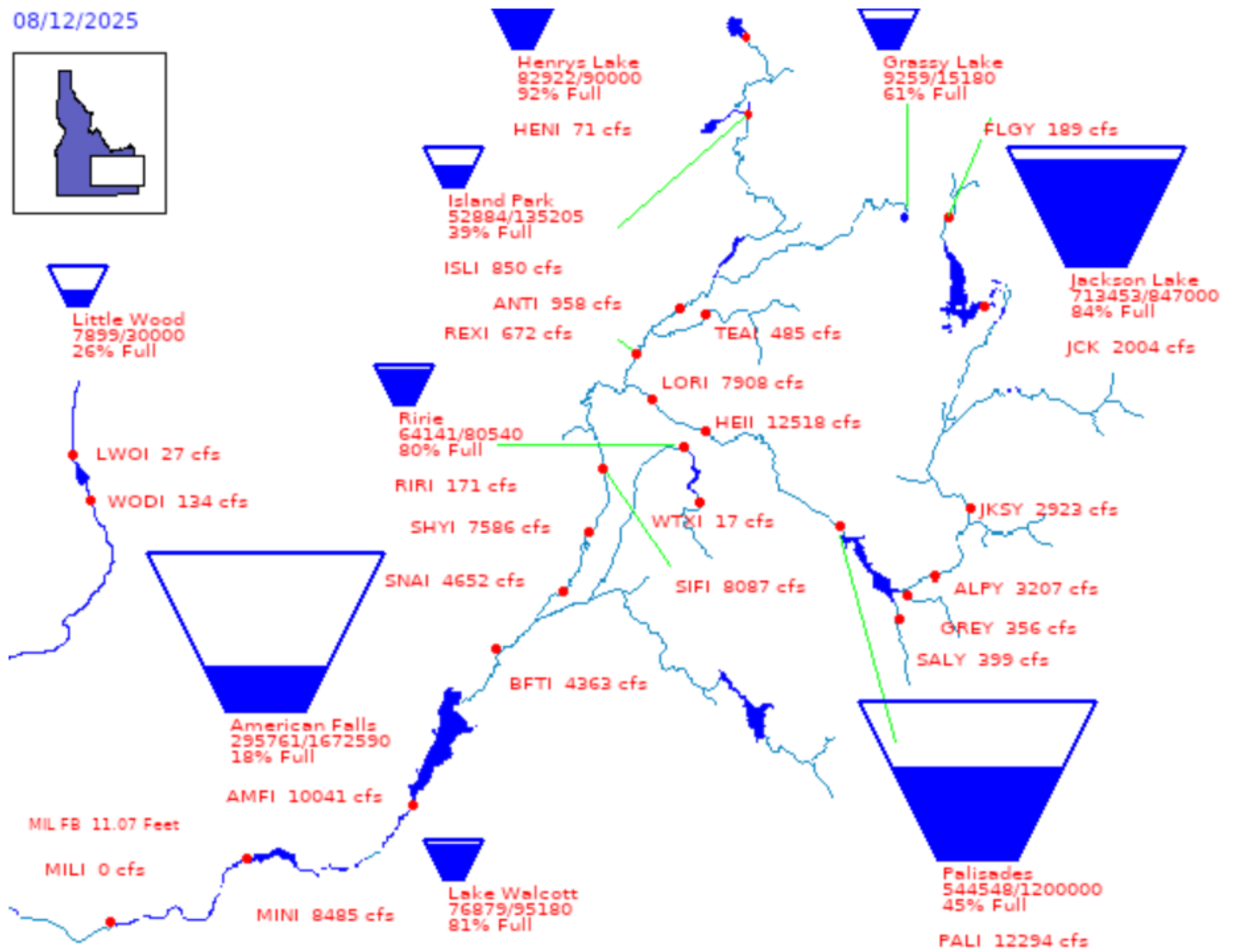
- 1889-05-01 Henry's Fork
- 1889-05-01 Fall River
- 1884-06-01 Teton River Above Island Ward Canal
- 1885-10-17 Teton River Lower North Fork
- 1888-08-13 Snake River Above Lorenzo
- 1889-05-01 Snake River Lorenzo to Blackfoot
- 1900-10-11 Snake River Below Blackfoot

Natural flow above Blackfoot remains significantly below average, ranking near the 10th percentile of the 30-year median—similar to the 2013 water year. Natural flow below Blackfoot is near the 30-year median, comparable to the 2021 irrigation season.

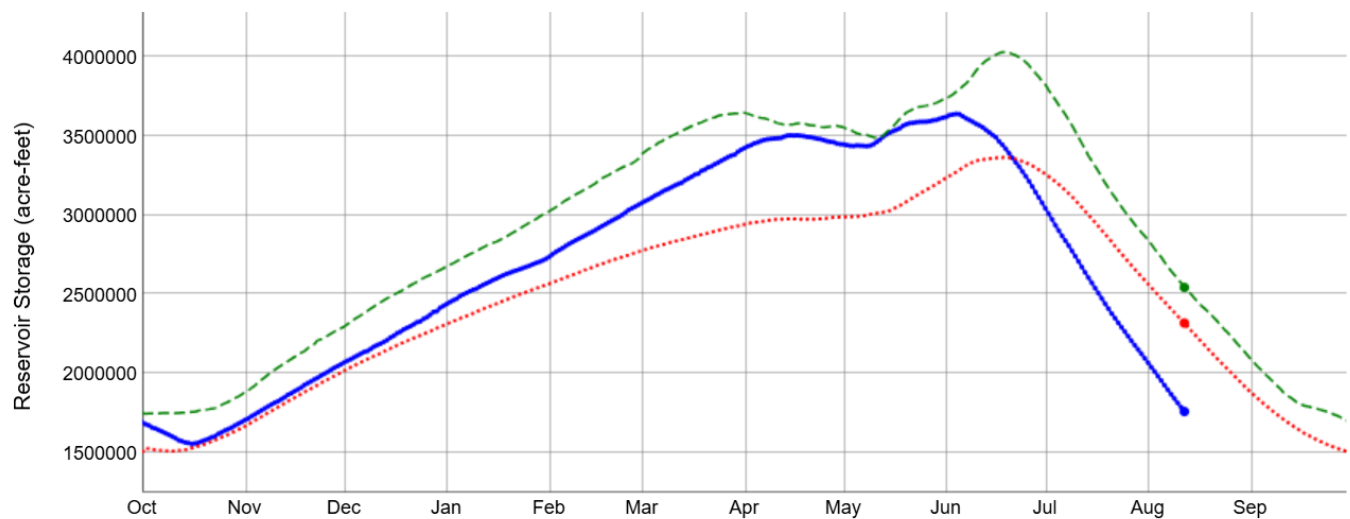

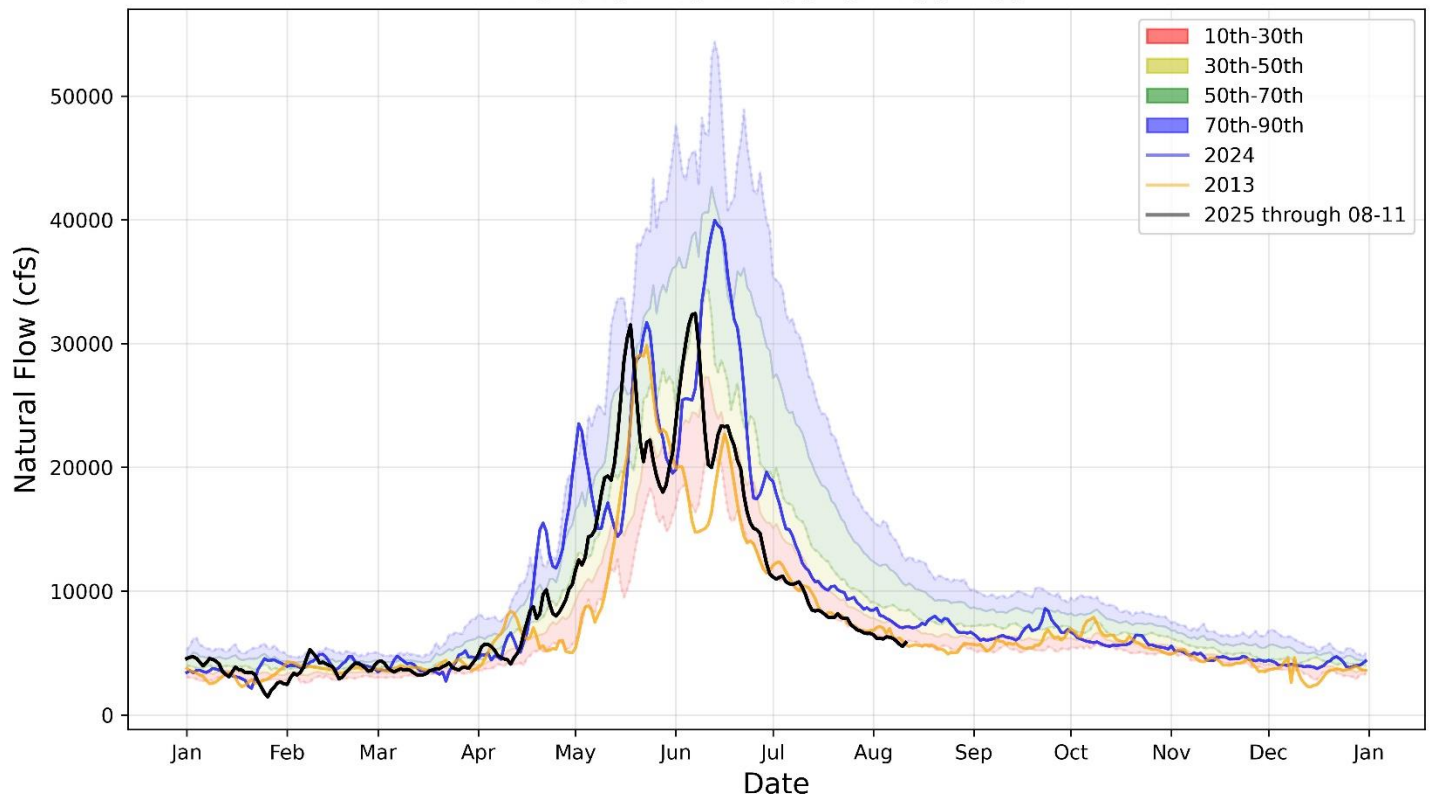

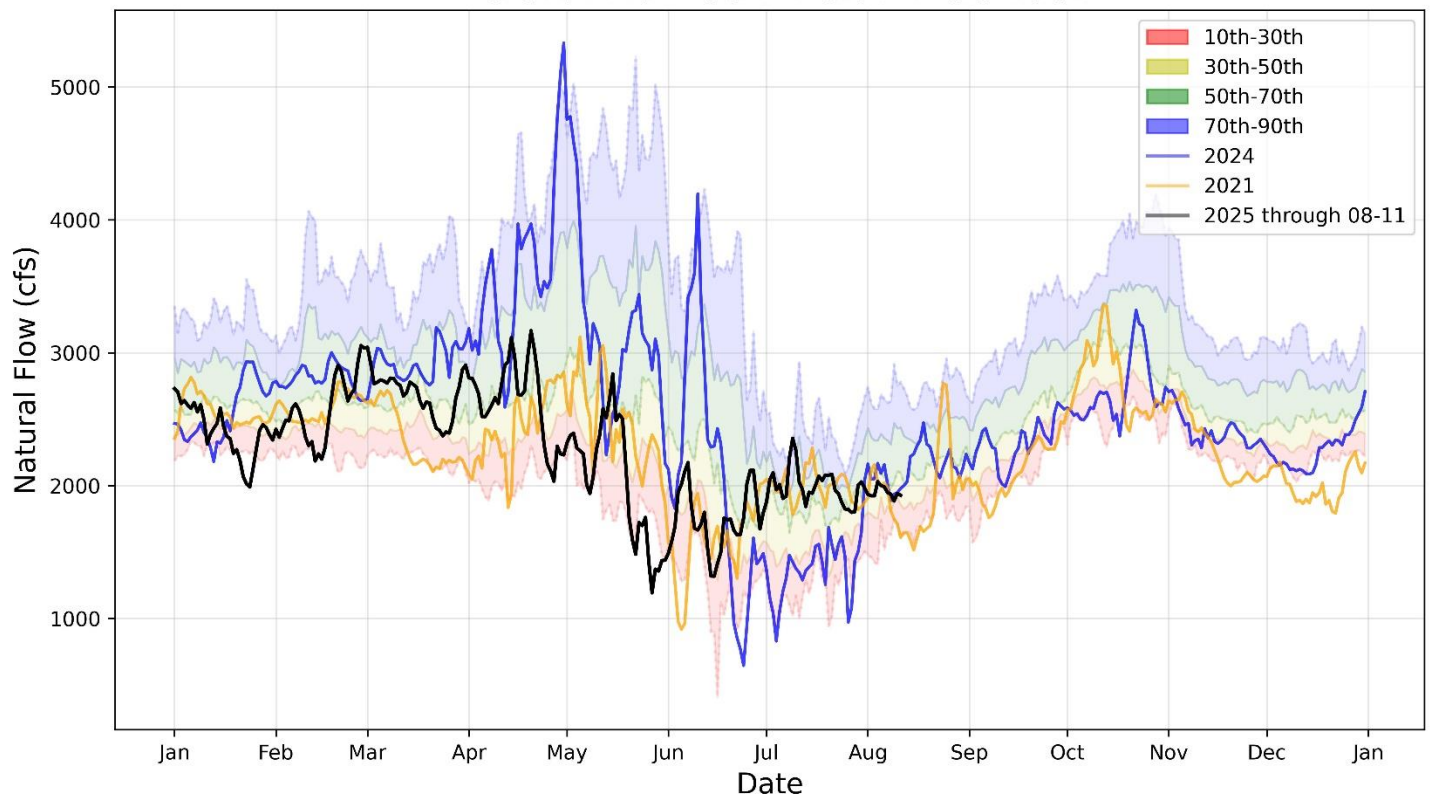
