

Water District 1 Report – July 15th, 2026

Over the past week, natural flow above Blackfoot has steadily decreased by an average of approximately 200 cfs per day and currently stands at just under 8,000 cfs. The overall diversion rate has remained relatively constant at approximately 13,500 cfs. Below Blackfoot, natural flow has remained steady at around 1,800 cfs, while the overall diversion rate has also remained stable at approximately 10,200 cfs. The current rate of system storage use is approximately 28,000 acre-feet per day.

Water right priorities above Blackfoot have continued to move to more senior dates and are currently around the 1890 level. Reach gains, or natural flow, above Blackfoot remain in poor condition, with available flow near the 10th percentile of the past 30 years. Only 2001 and 2007 had clearly lower reach gains during this period. Natural flow above Blackfoot is following a pattern similar to 2025, which is used as the analog year in the attached priority comparison. In 2025, the priority remained near the 1889–1890 level for the following two weeks of July. The Teton River has separated onto its own, more senior priority and will likely remain separate for the remainder of the irrigation season.

The water-right priority below Blackfoot is October 11, 1900, and is expected to remain at that date for the rest of the irrigation season unless significant precipitation occurs. This is the most senior, large priority below Blackfoot and is limited to reach gains arising below Blackfoot. All reach gains originating above Blackfoot are currently being delivered to more senior priority water rights above Blackfoot.

The projected priorities for tomorrow are:

Teton River: June 1, 1885

Snake River above Blackfoot: July 10, 1889

Snake River below Blackfoot: October 11, 1900

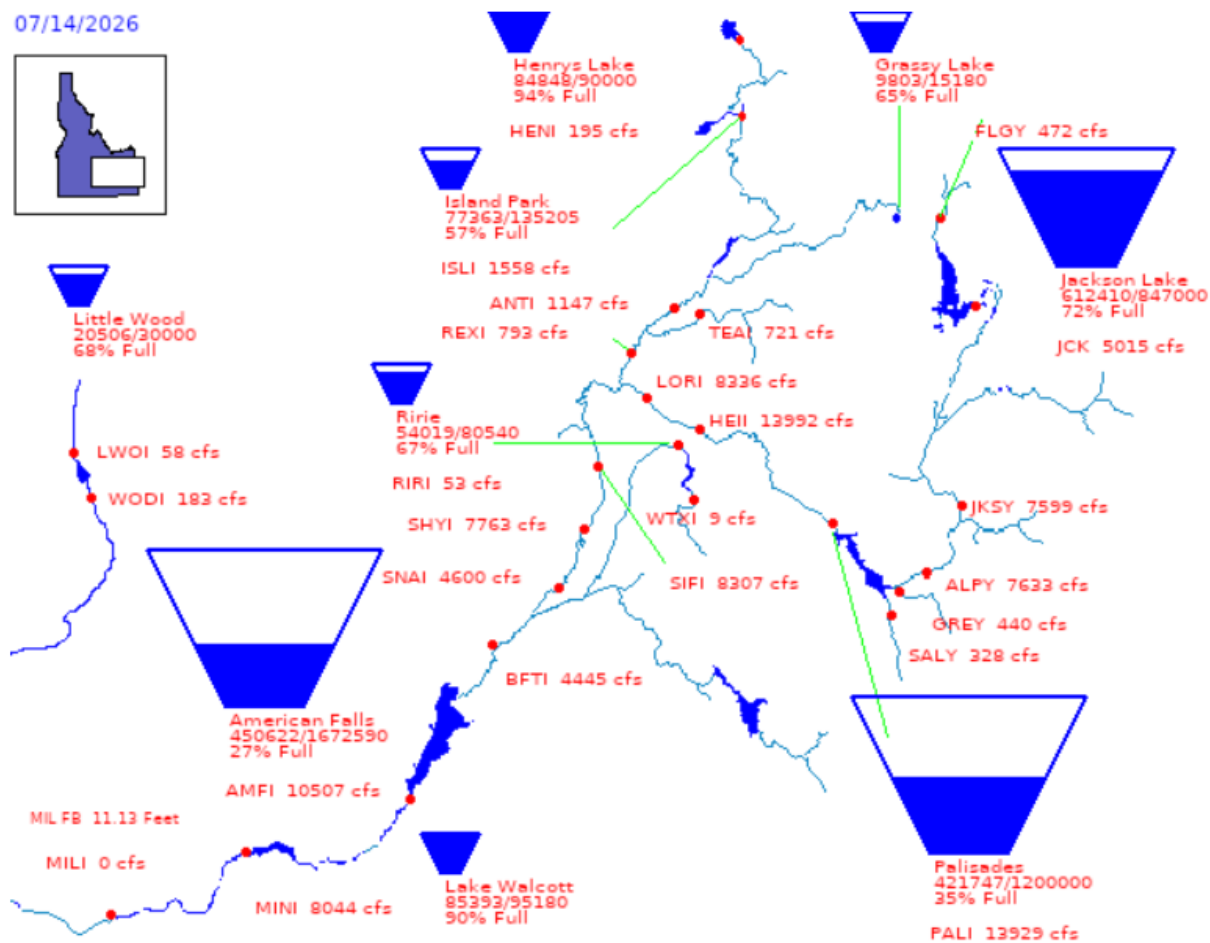
All of eastern Idaho is currently classified as experiencing drought by the U.S. Drought Monitor, with most of the region classified as being in severe to extreme drought.

Forecasts call for continued above average temperatures and chances of precipitation during the coming week. Any precipitation would need to be both significant and widespread across the watershed to substantially affect the current water right priority trend.

Major Storage Reservoirs in the Upper Snake River Basin

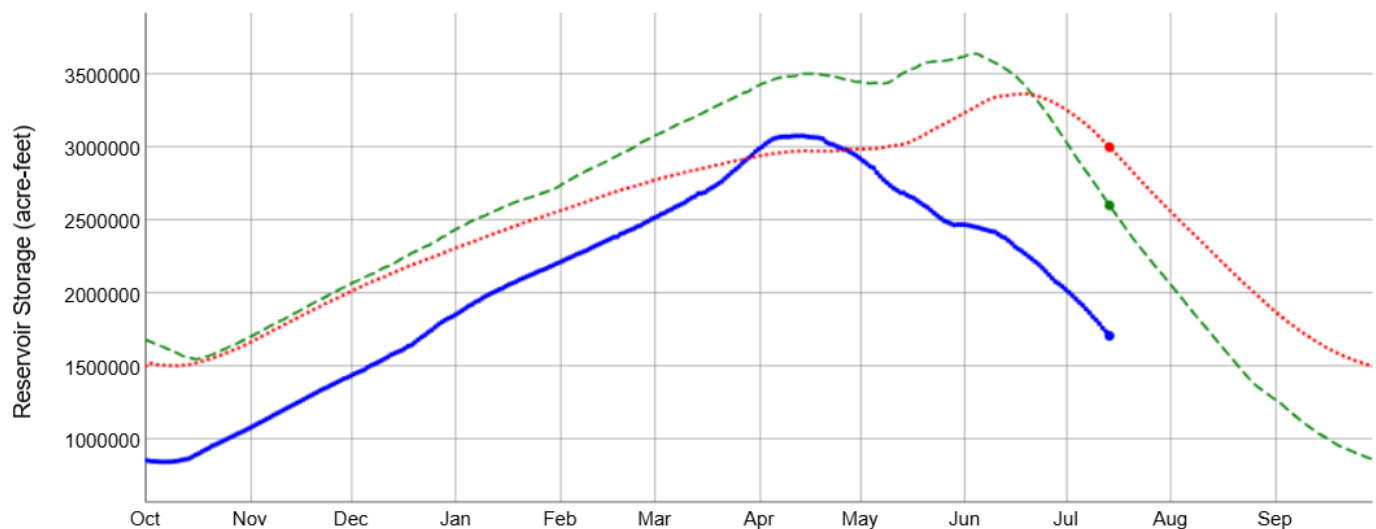

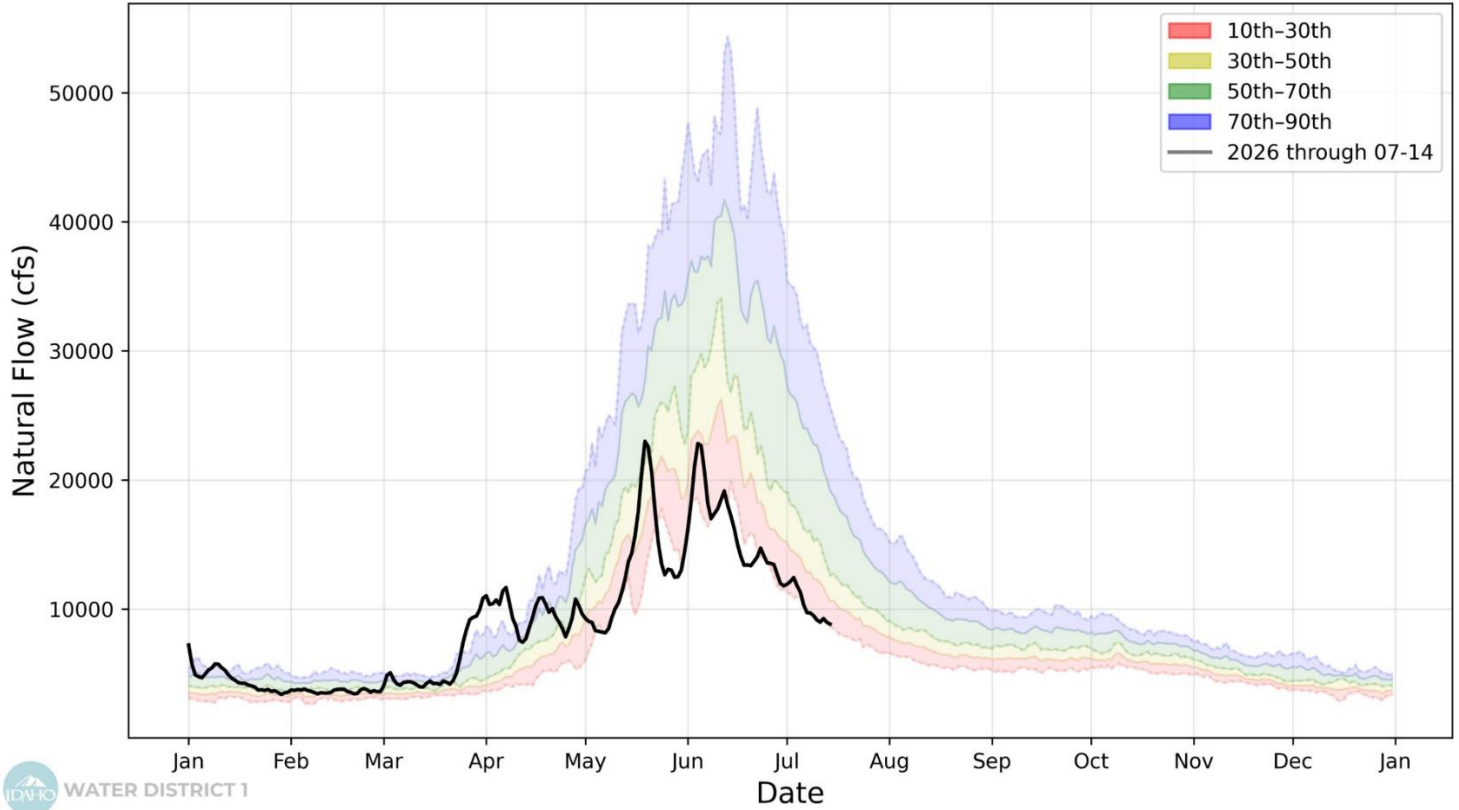

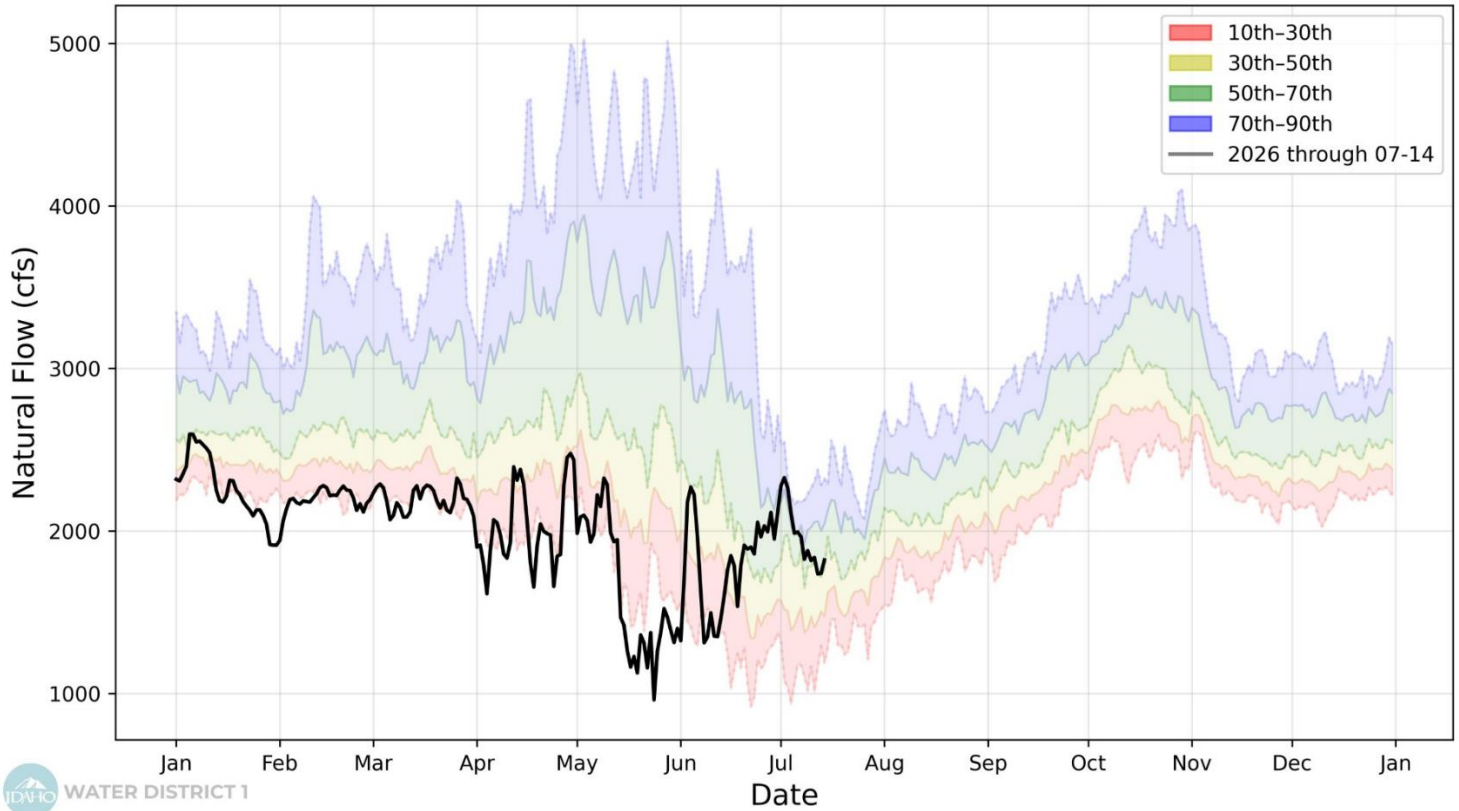


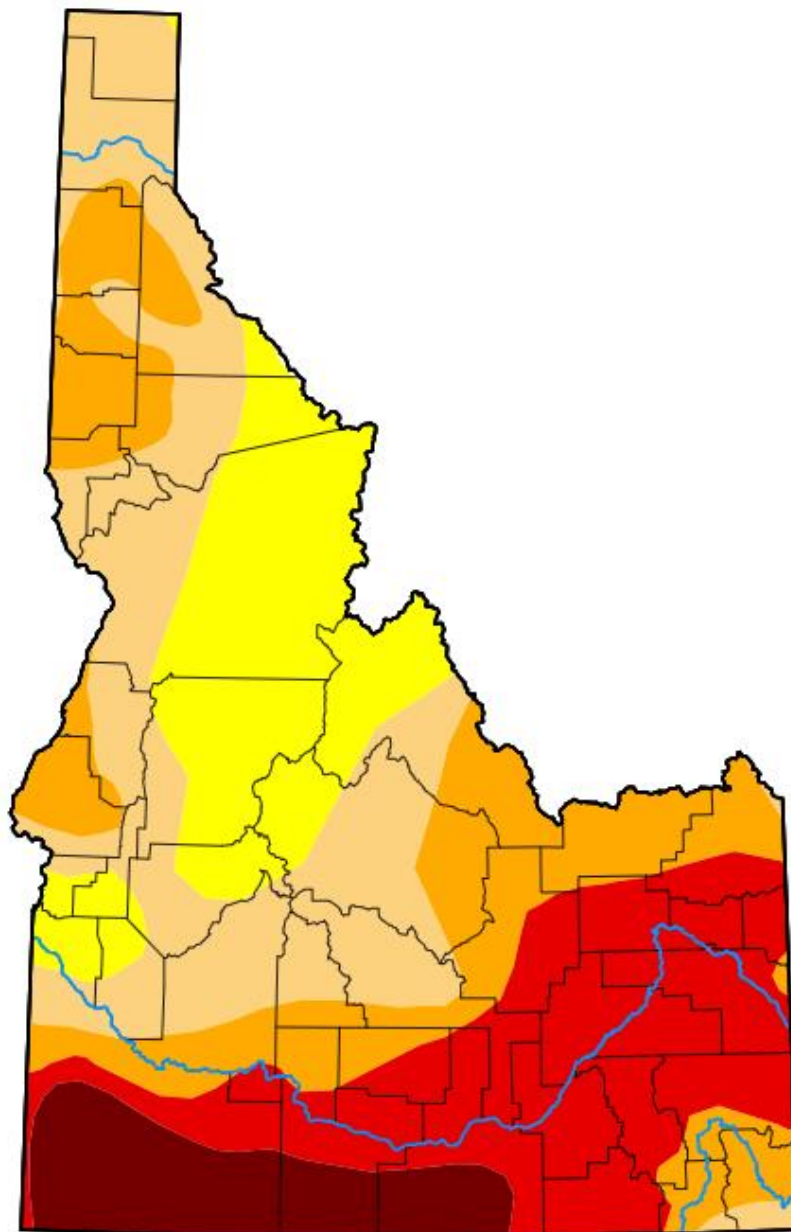
