

Water District 1 Report – July 22nd, 2026

Above average temperatures and scattered showers occurred over the past week. However, precipitation amounts were insufficient to meaningfully alter the current water supply trajectory.

Above Blackfoot, the effect on natural-flow supply was minimal, although the precipitation appears to have slowed the rate of decline. Last week's report showed natural flow decreasing by approximately 200 cfs per day, while this week's data indicate a decline of closer to 80 cfs per day. Diversions have also decreased, averaging approximately 180 cfs per day decrease, likely due to a combination of weather conditions and crop timing. Natural flow above Blackfoot is currently approximately 7,500 cfs, while diversions are approximately 12,000 cfs.

The water-right priority above Blackfoot has generally plateaued and continues to hover near the 1890 level. Natural-flow conditions remain very poor, with available supply near the 10th percentile of the past 30 years. Natural flow and water right priorities in 2026 continue to track closely with conditions observed in 2025 and 2013. The attached priority comparison illustrates these relationships and shows how priorities progressed in 2025.

Below Blackfoot, natural flow and diversions have remained relatively steady at approximately 1,500 cfs and 10,000 cfs, respectively.

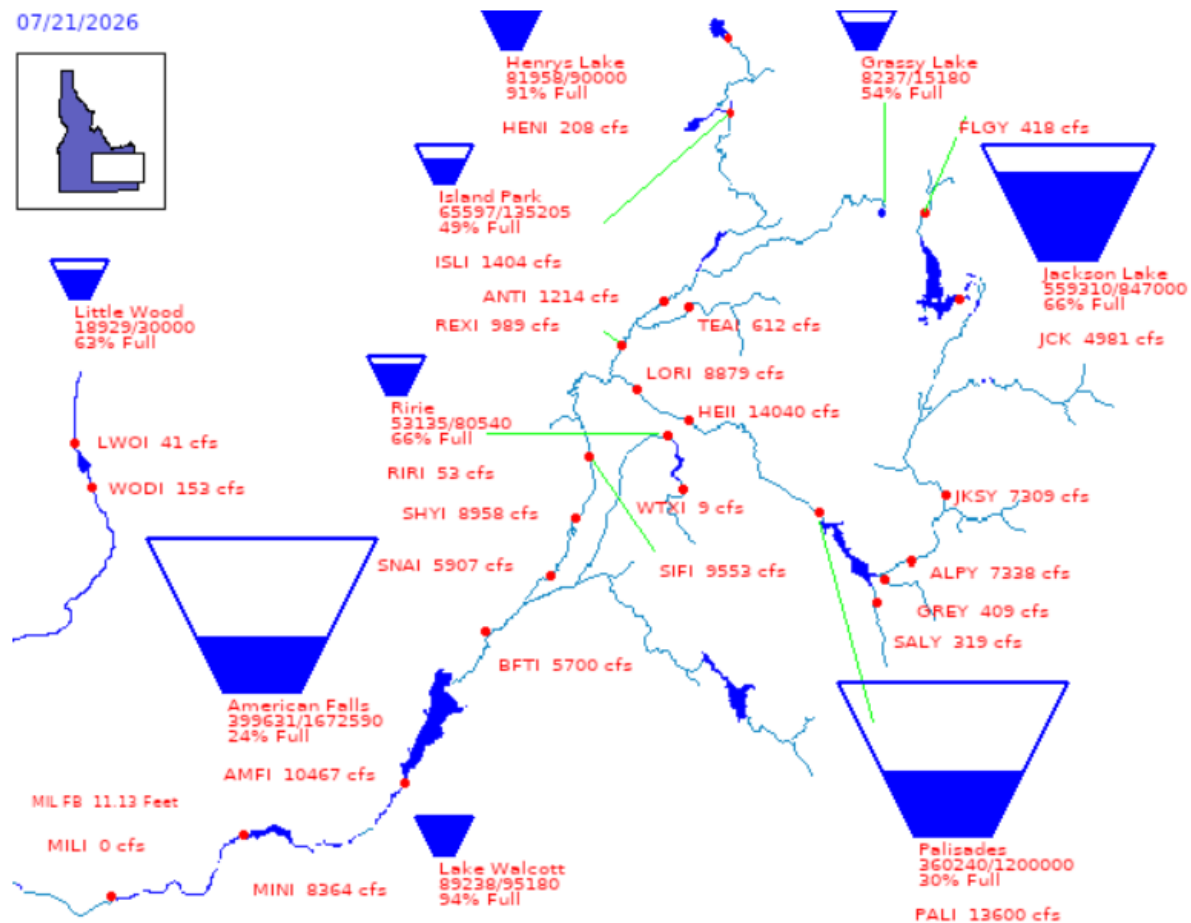
Several canals have either exhausted their storage supplies or are approaching exhaustion. Canal managers are encouraged to closely monitor their remaining storage balances and plan accordingly. Diversions relying on storage beyond the amount available will be curtailed.

The physical reservoir system is currently 38 percent full and is drafting rapidly, with system wide storage use of approximately 27,000 acre-feet per day. Current projections indicate that reservoir levels will be very low by the end of the irrigation season.

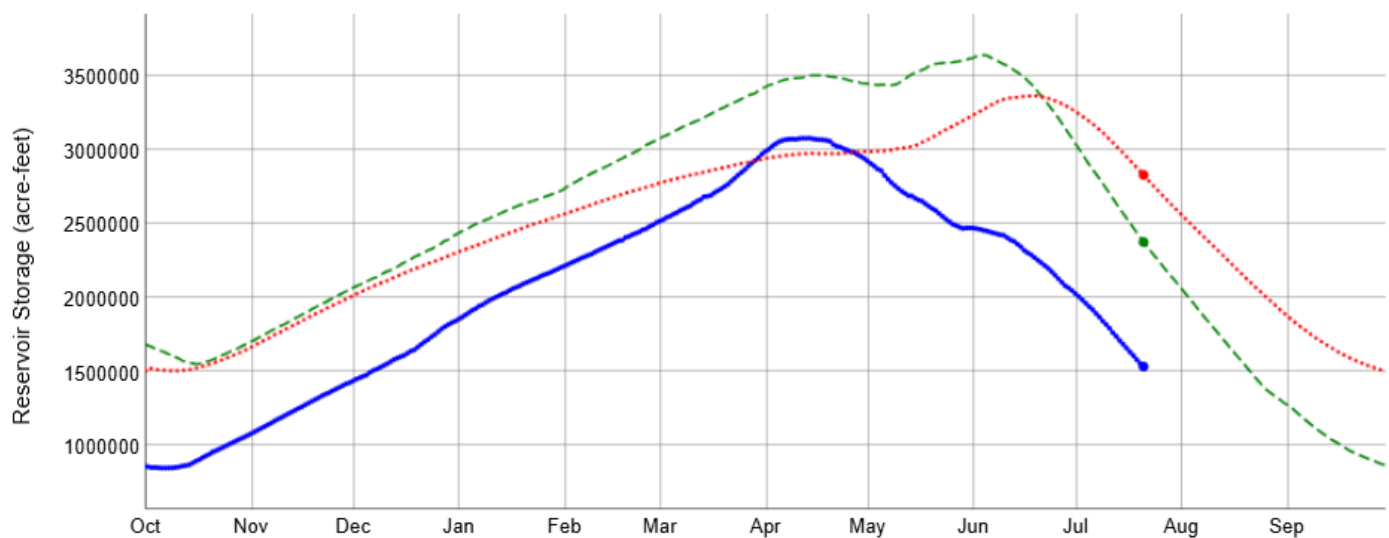

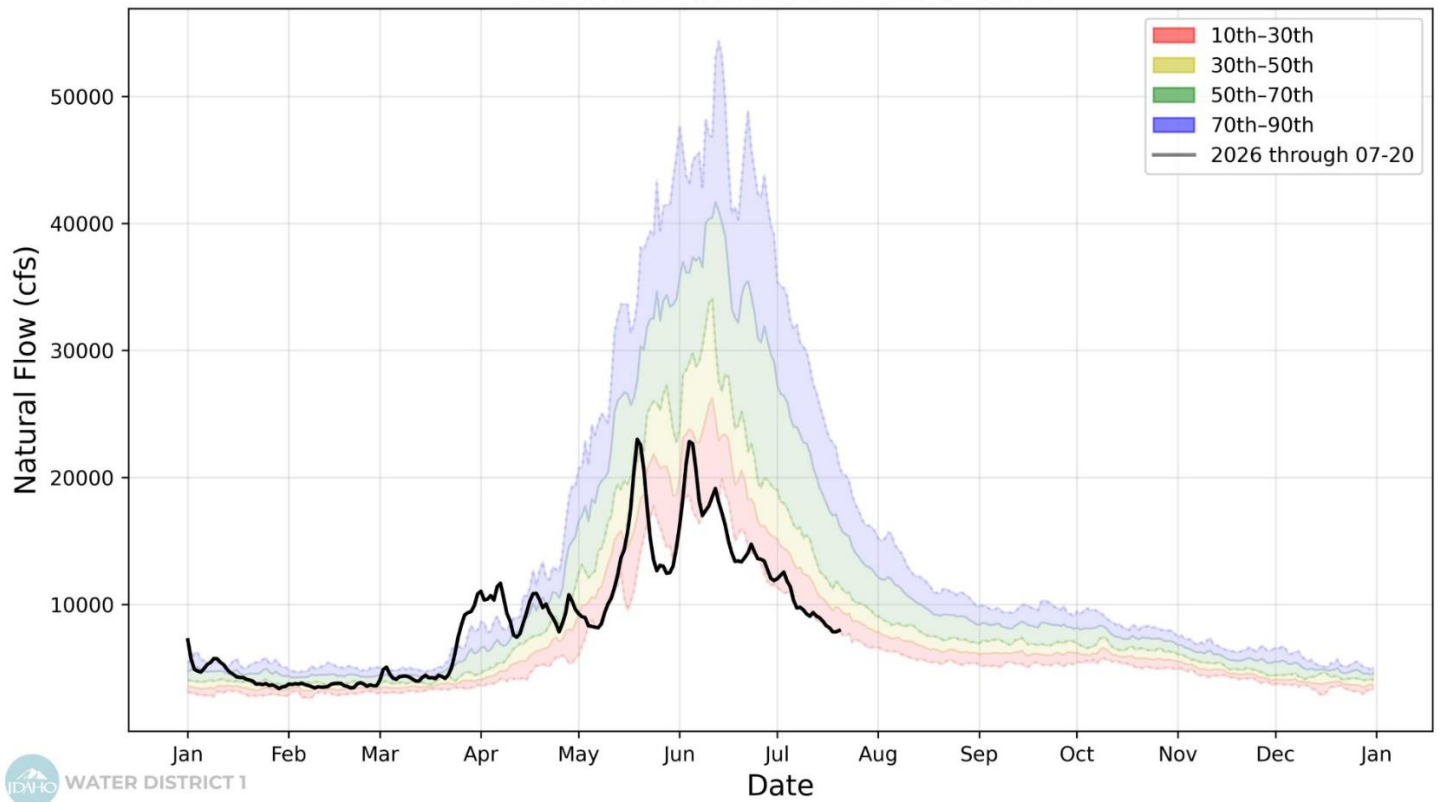

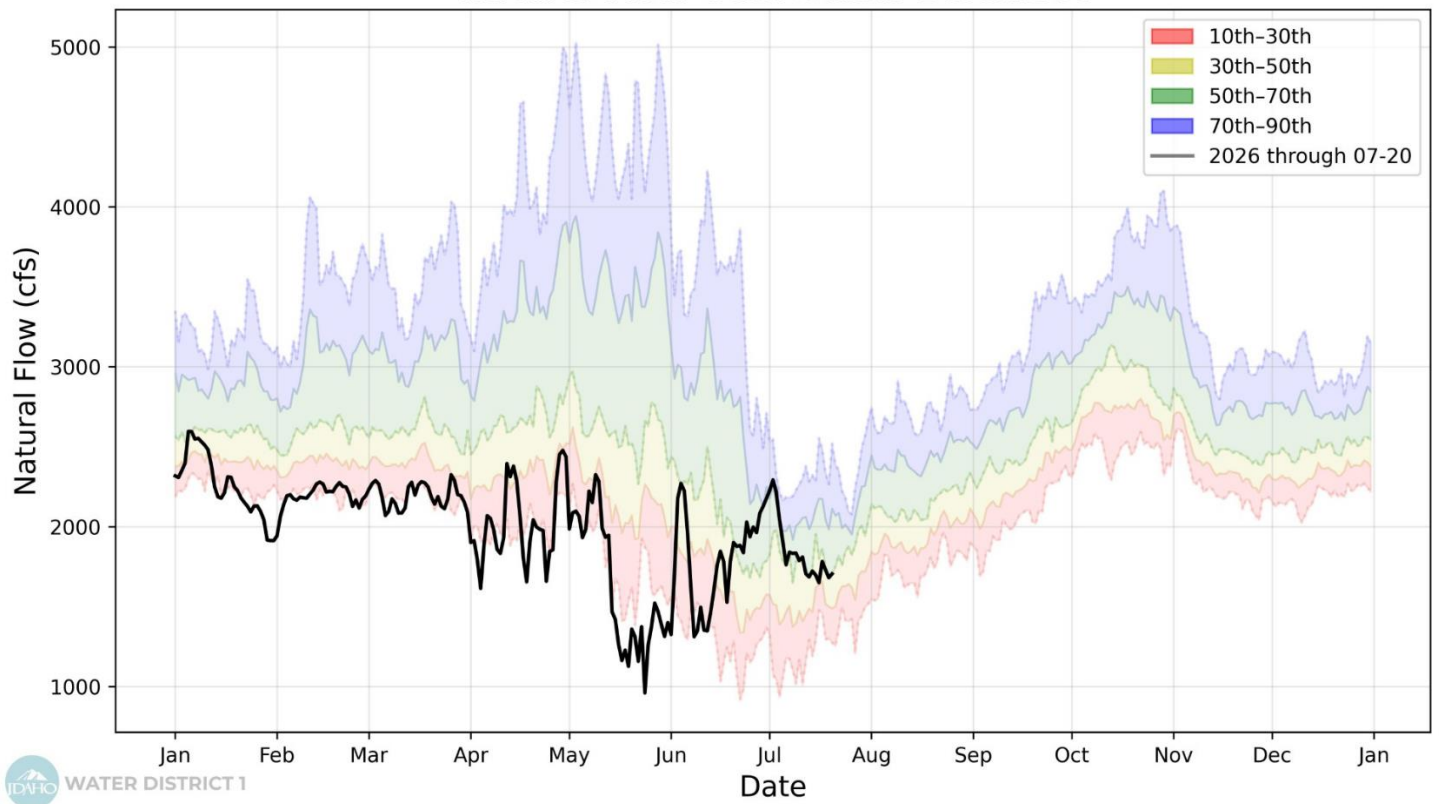
