

## **WATER REPORT – May 23, 2023**

Over this past week approximately 40,000 acre-feet of storage per day has been stored in the reservoir system while satisfying natural-flow diversions up to the July 28, 1939 priority. The reservoir system is currently 75% full, with approximately 1,040,000 acre-feet of empty reservoir space remaining to be filled. The Jackson Lake-1913, Henrys Lake-1917, Island Park-1935, Grassy Lake-1936, and Palisades Reservoir-1939 storage rights are all currently accruing additional storage towards their 2023 storage allocations.

The American Falls Reservoir storage right has already accrued 100% of its storage volume. The Jackson Lake-1913 storage right is expected to reach 100% accrual within the next week. It remains uncertain at this time whether natural flow will remain high enough through June to provide for 100% accrual to the Henrys Lake-1917, Island Park-1935, Grassy Lake-1936, Palisades-1939, Ririe-1969 and the 276,363 acre-feet of reservoir system (last-to-fill) space evacuated to supply previous years' Rental Pool leases.

The July 28, 1939 priority is expected to be filled for at least the remainder of this week. Another water right accounting will be computed on Friday to more precisely determine priorities projected to be filled during the upcoming Memorial Day weekend.
