

Water District 1 Report – August 26th, 2026

Following the significant increase in natural flow Above Blackfoot resulting from precipitation over the weekend of August 15–16, natural flow has receded to the trend line it has generally followed this summer, closely resembling 2025 and 2013. Each time precipitation has been sufficient to improve water right priorities this summer, natural flow has subsequently returned to this same trend.

As noted previously, 2025 and 2013 were both very poor natural flow years. However, the continued correlation provides irrigators with a useful roadmap for how water right priorities may move through the remainder of the season. An attached priority comparison shows how priorities continued to move well into September during 2025.

The correlation with analog years is not as strong Below Blackfoot as it is Above Blackfoot because reach gains Below Blackfoot tend to be more volatile. Analog years have shifted through the season. Nonetheless, Below Blackfoot natural flow is currently tracking most closely with the 2004 water year. The attached priority comparison shows how this reach gain moved during 2004.

The projected water right priorities for tomorrow, August 27, are listed below.

Above Blackfoot natural flow is approximately 5,500 cfs, while diversions are approximately 9,300 cfs. Below Blackfoot natural flow is approximately 2,000 cfs, while diversions are approximately 9,000 cfs. These conditions are resulting in approximately 21,000 acre-feet of storage being diverted each day.

The Upper Snake River reservoir system continues to draft rapidly and is currently at 18% of capacity. Physical storage levels in individual reservoirs are being actively managed to ensure that storage holders can take delivery of their remaining storage supplies throughout the system. Many operations are planning to draw remaining storage accounts to zero or to below normal levels. As a result, system carryover is on pace to be very low.

The Committee of Nine meeting originally scheduled for Thursday, September 3, has been rescheduled to October 28 to better align with harvest and year end fiscal and water accounting.

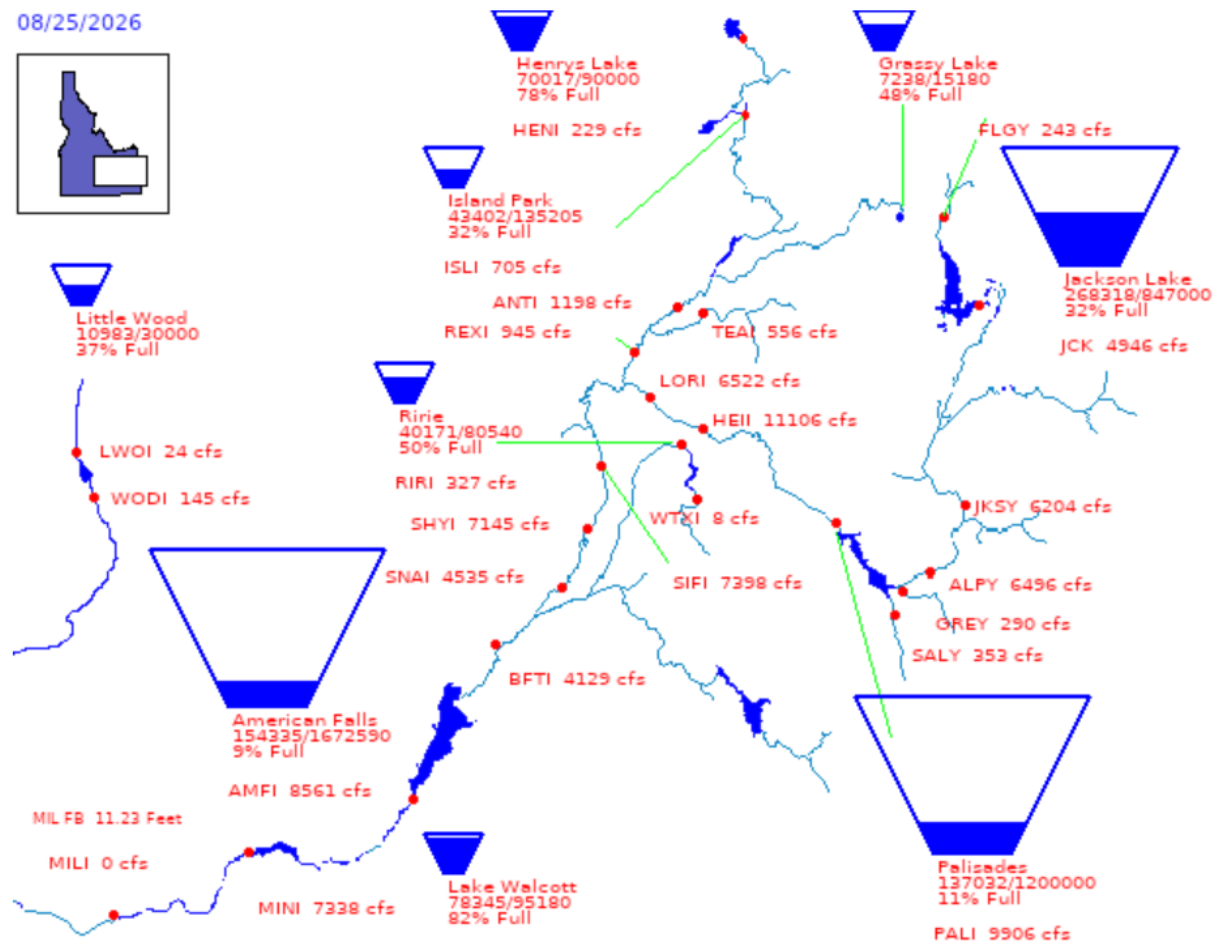

Major Storage Reservoirs in the Upper Snake River Basin

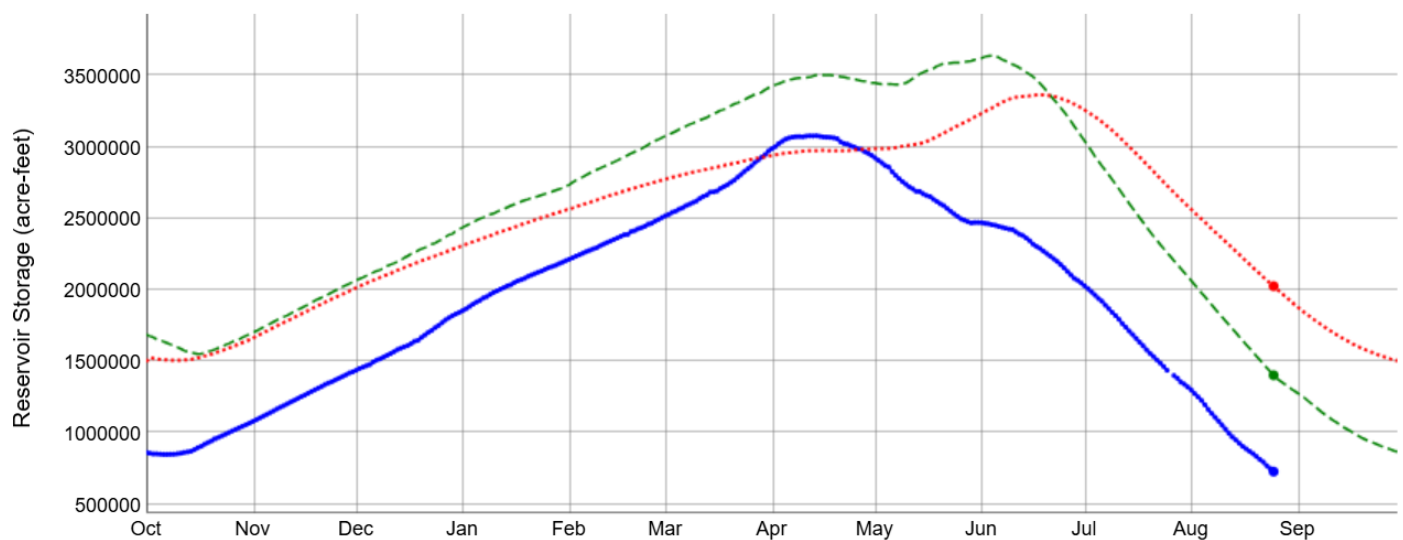

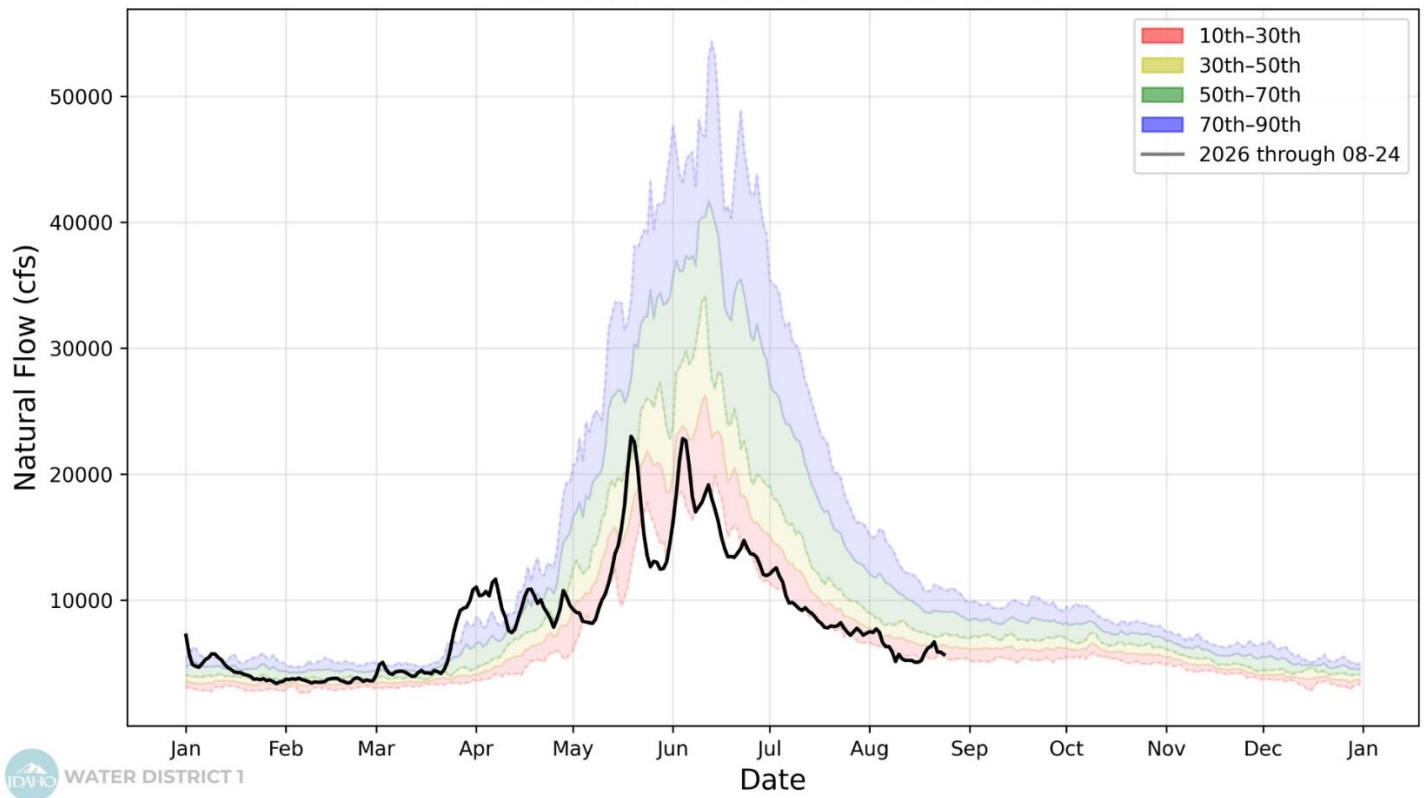

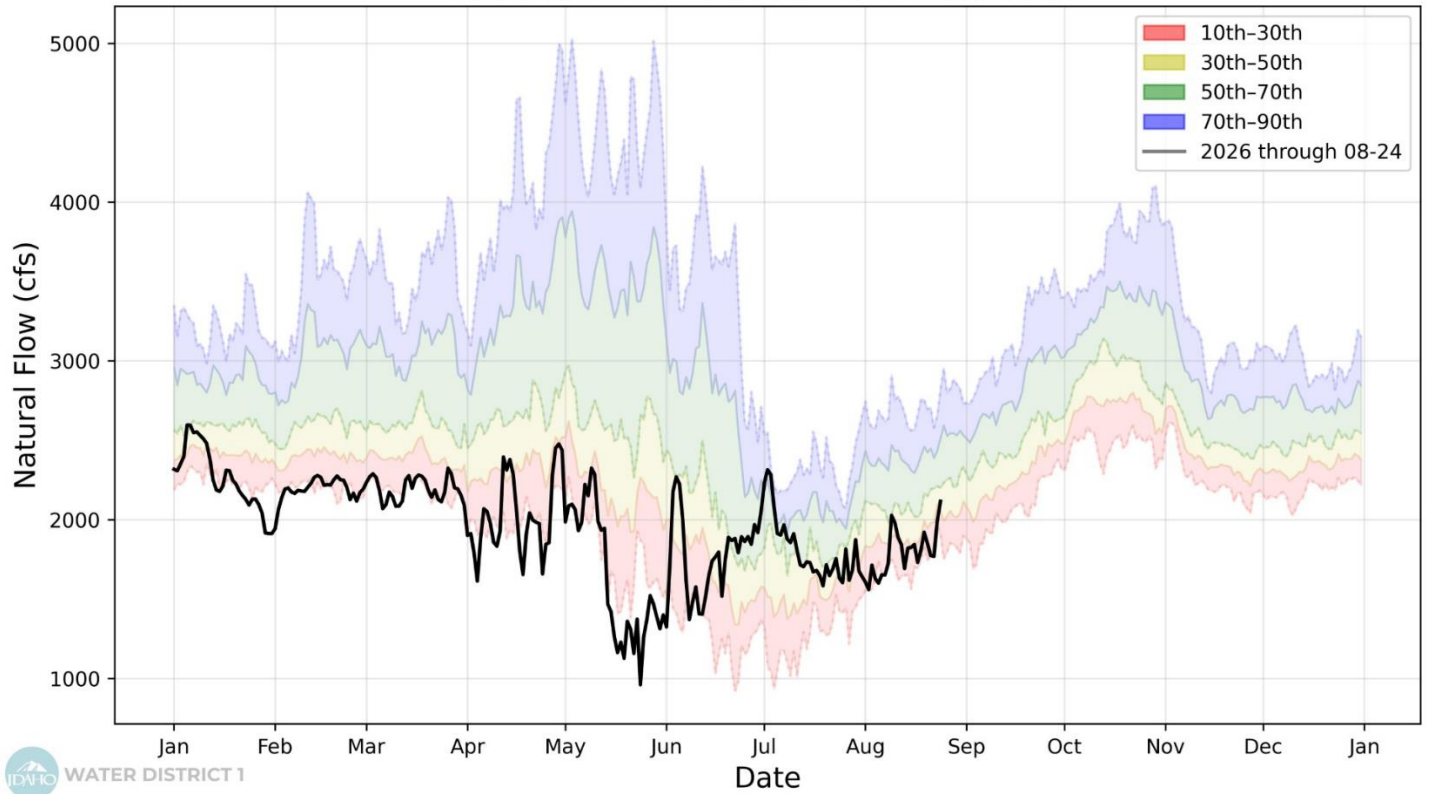
