

Water District 1 Report – September 3rd, 2026

Precipitation received over the weekend, together with the cooler temperatures and scattered showers that followed, has modestly improved water supply conditions Above Blackfoot. Natural flow has increased by approximately 500 cfs, while diversion demand has decreased by roughly 300 cfs. This combination has slightly improved water right priorities and they continue to hover in the 1889–1890 range. Natural flow Above Blackfoot is currently approximately 5,700 cfs, compared with diversions of approximately 8,700 cfs.

Below Blackfoot, natural flow is approximately 2,000 cfs. Diversions have declined by roughly 500 cfs and are currently approximately 8,500 cfs.

The improved natural flow supply and lower diversion demand have reduced system storage use slightly, to approximately 20,000 acre-feet per day. Two large diversions are scheduled to shut off next week after exhausting their remaining storage supplies.

Reach gains Above Blackfoot continue to track closely with the 2025 season, while reach gains Below Blackfoot continue to track near 2004 levels. The attached priority comparison uses those years as analogs to help water managers anticipate how natural flow and water right priorities may move through September.

The projected water-right priorities for tomorrow are:

Falls River:	May 11, 1889
Henry's Fork:	May 11, 1889
Teton River:	June 1, 1885
Teton Lower North Fork:	June 1, 1885
SNAKE RIVER ABOVE LORENZO:	May 11, 1889
SNAKE RIVER, LORENZO TO BLACKFOOT:	May 11, 1889
SNAKE RIVER BELOW BLACKFOOT:	October 11, 1900

The physical reservoir system is currently at 14 percent of capacity and is tracking near the 2003 and 2004 trajectories, which are two of the lowest in recent history. At this point in the season, system contents are slightly below both years. The system is therefore on pace to reach one of the lowest end of season storage levels in recent memory.

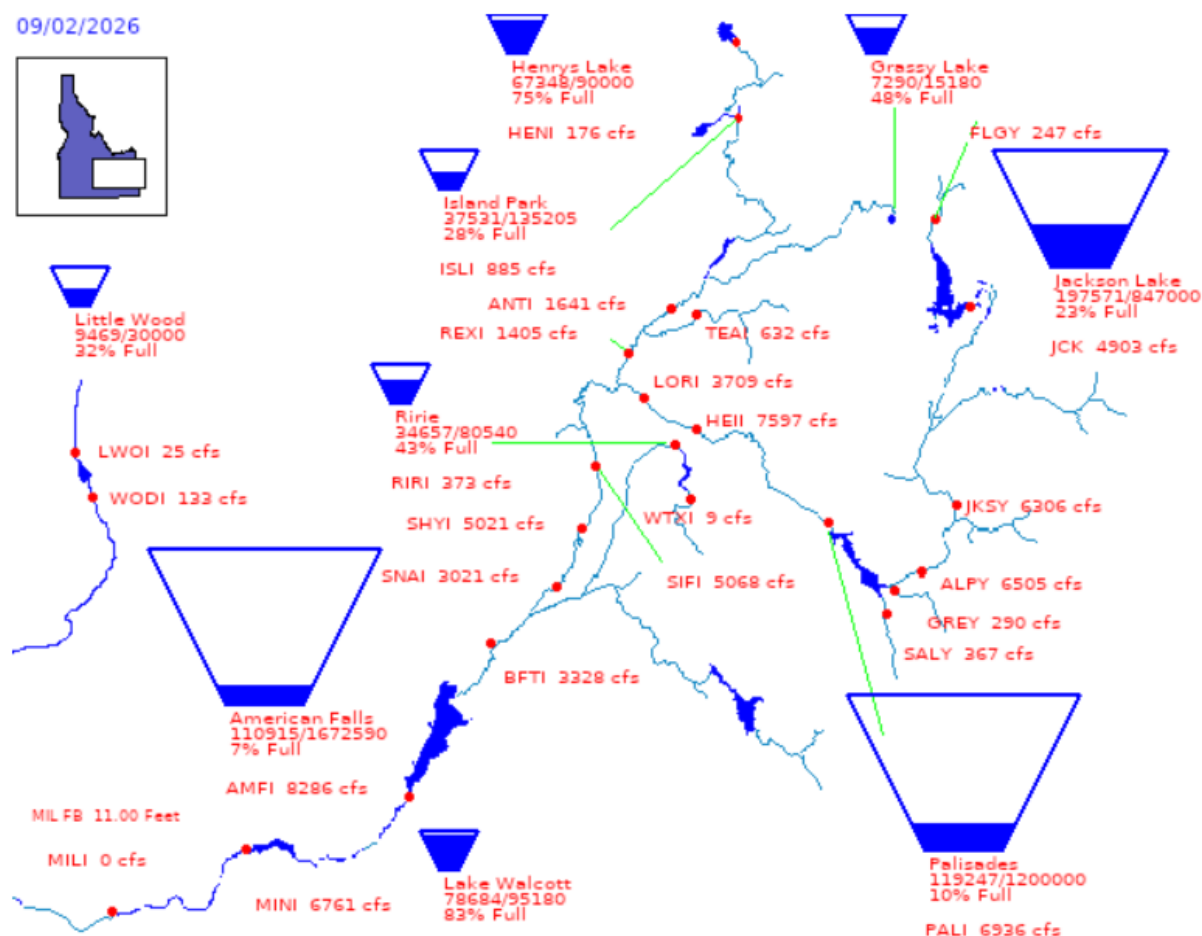
An analysis of carryover over the past 30 years has been compiled in the attached table. Based on current projections, a complete system refill in 2027 appears highly unlikely, and there is a meaningful risk that the American Falls 1921 storage right will not fill completely. Under the system's priority sequence, the American Falls 1921 right must fill before storage can accrue to junior reservoir rights, including Island Park 1935, Grassy Lake 1936, Palisades 1939, and Ririe 1969.

Major Storage Reservoirs in the Upper Snake River Basin

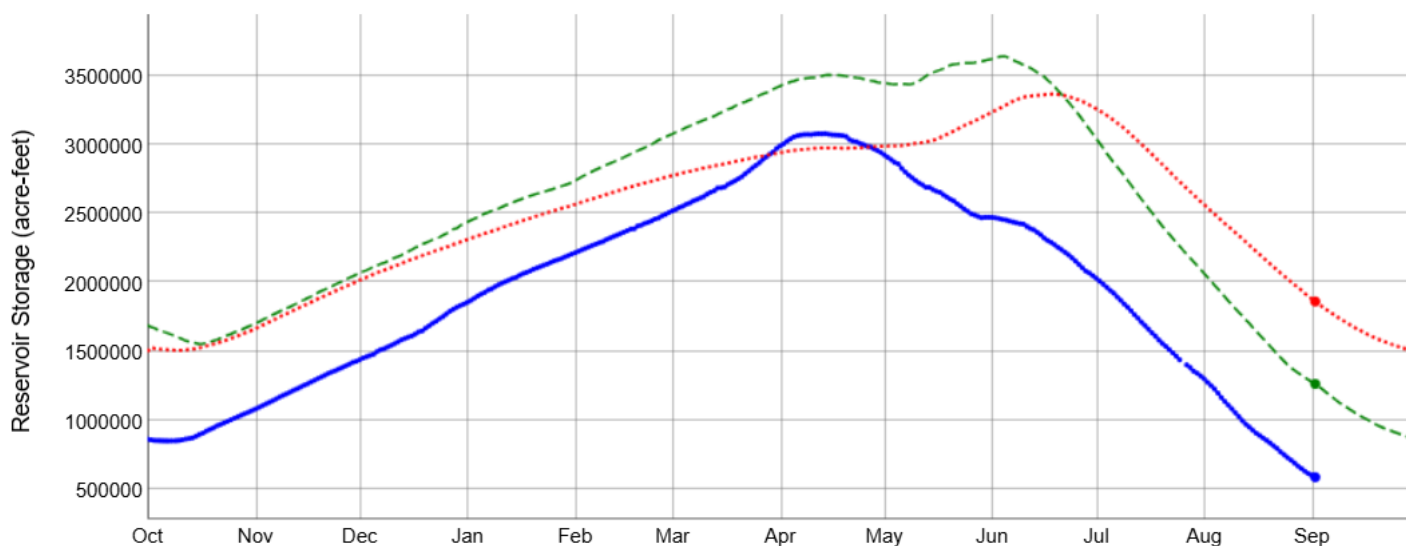

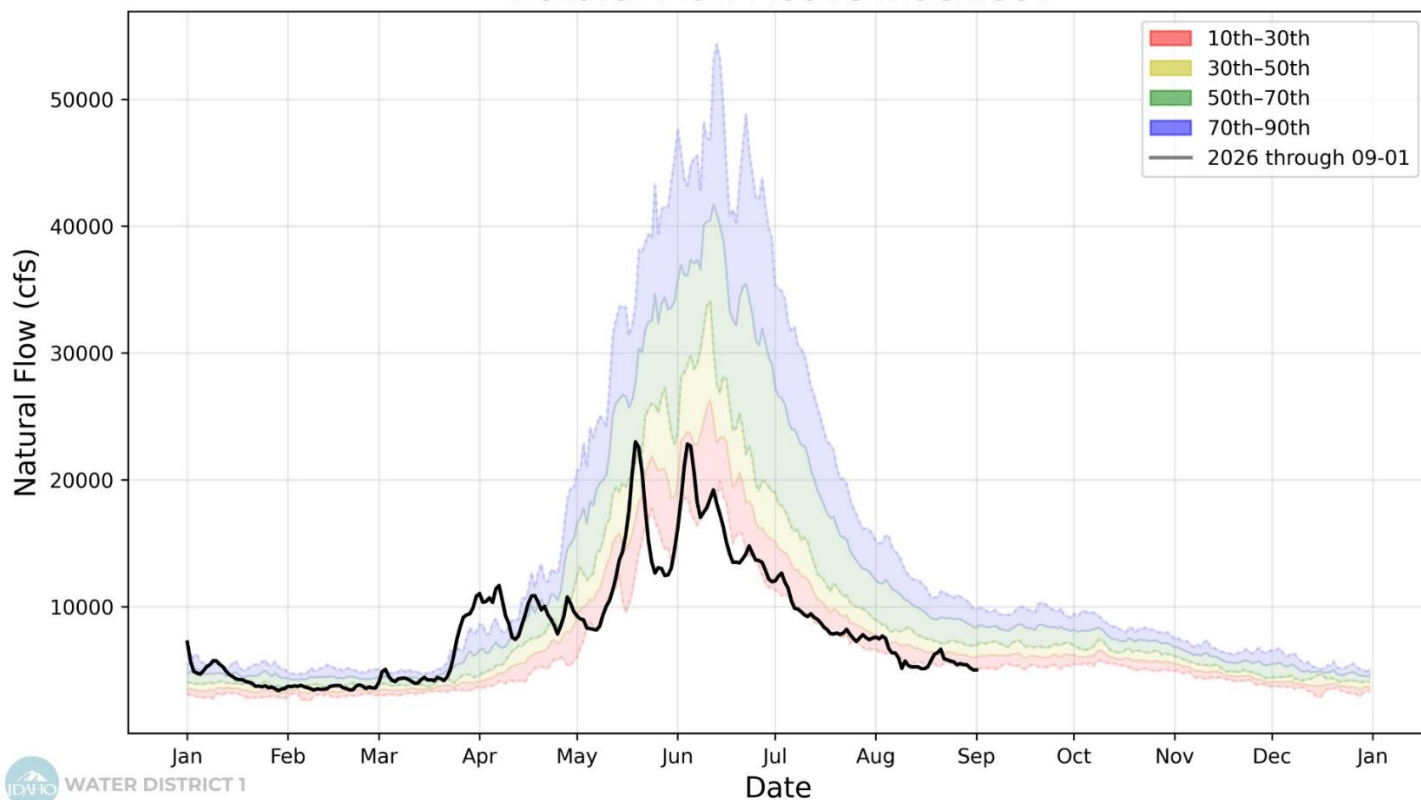

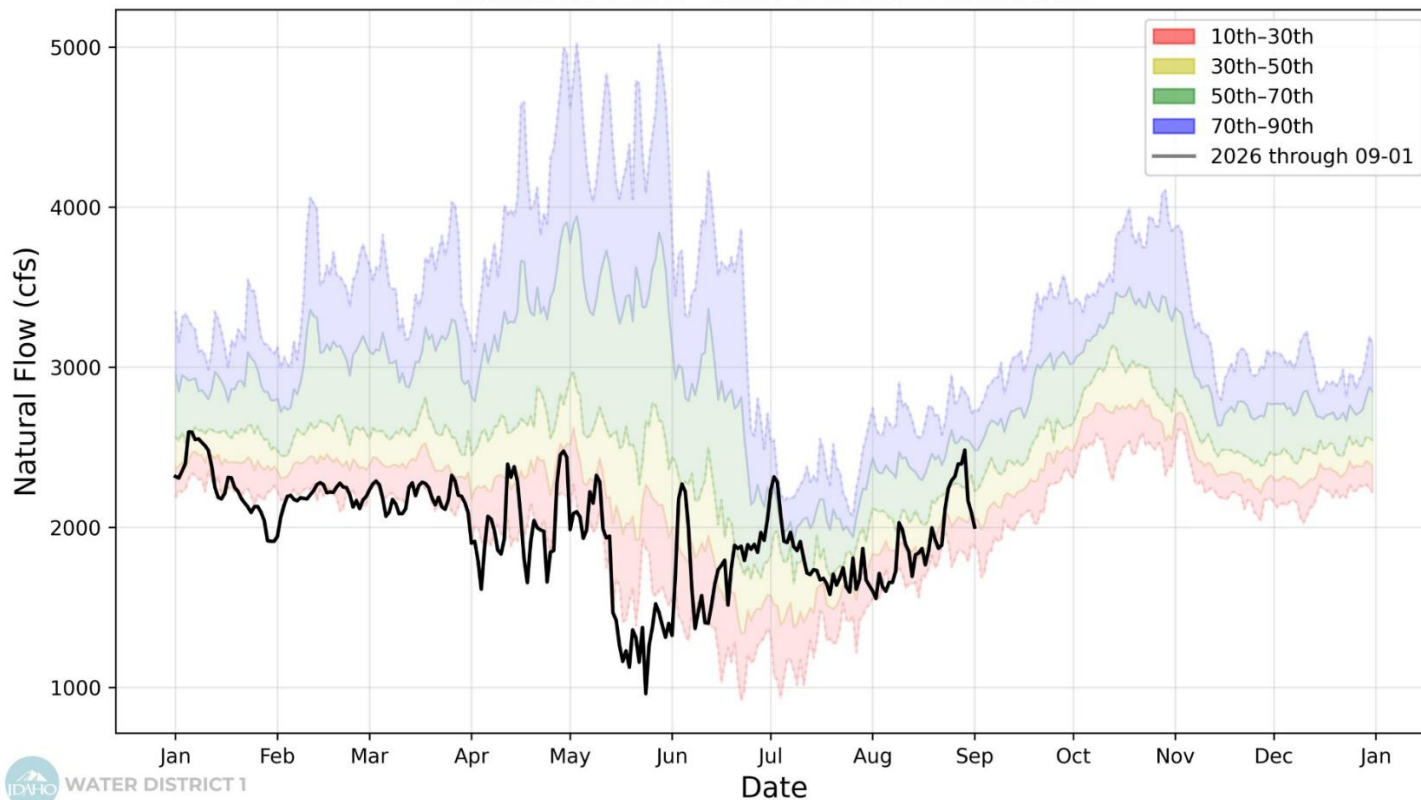
