

WATER REPORT – May 10, 2022

Over the past week, diversions have increased by approximately 2000 cfs while natural flow has increased by approximately 3000 cfs. Most of the natural flow increase has come from snow melt above Palisades Reservoir. Reservoir water rights are fluctuating between on and off right now, with total natural flow and total diversions close. The rate of snow melt and irrigation demand will determine which water right priorities are filled over the next couple weeks. Once the snow starts to melt off rapidly, the 1921 American Falls water right will come solidly into priority. The 1905-10-07 water right is currently being filled for all reaches, but this can change daily with the considerations discussed above.

Canal managers are cautioned to watch their storage usage so as not to unnecessarily use a significant amount of their 2022 storage allocation early in the irrigation season. Water-right priorities currently projected to be filled are posted under the CURRENT DATA tab of the www.waterdistrict1.com webpage.

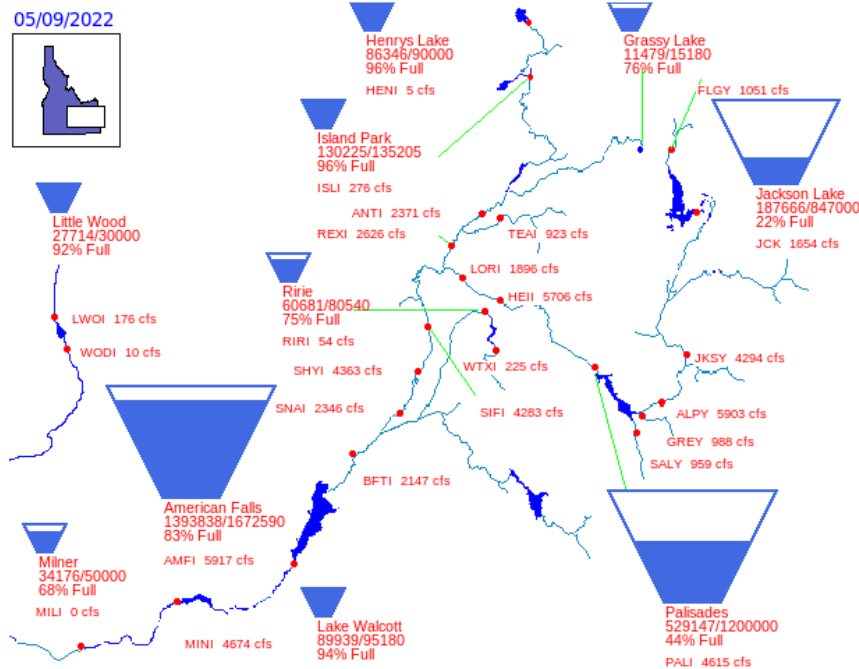
