

Water District 1 Report – September 10th, 2025

Natural flow above Blackfoot has leveled off, holding near 5,100 cfs—about where it was before the widespread precipitation event a couple of weeks ago. Conditions remain historically low, ranking among the driest years in the past 30-year record. Diversion demand rebounded briefly but has since declined again, reflecting both crop maturity and canal managers' efforts to conserve remaining storage supplies. Together, these dynamics have kept water right priorities hovering in the 1889–1890 range. In the absence of significant rainfall, natural flow is expected to continue its gradual decline, while diversion demand may fluctuate modestly as some operations wind down and others prepare for a final push before harvest. Current projections indicate a complete fill for the **May 11, 1889** water right.

At Lorenzo, the priority split has continued to toggle on and off. Present projections show it connected with the mainstem Snake River priority, also at May 11, 1889.

Weather forecasts suggest scattered showers over the coming days, which may cause minor adjustments to priorities, but no significant upward shift is expected.

WD1 is projecting a partial water right fill of the following priorities for tomorrow, September 11th:

1889-05-11 Fall River

1885-06-01 Teton River Above Island Ward Canal

1885-10-17 Teton River Lower North Fork

1889-05-11 Snake River Above Lorenzo

1889-05-11 Snake River Lorenzo to Blackfoot

1900-10-11 Snake River below Blackfoot

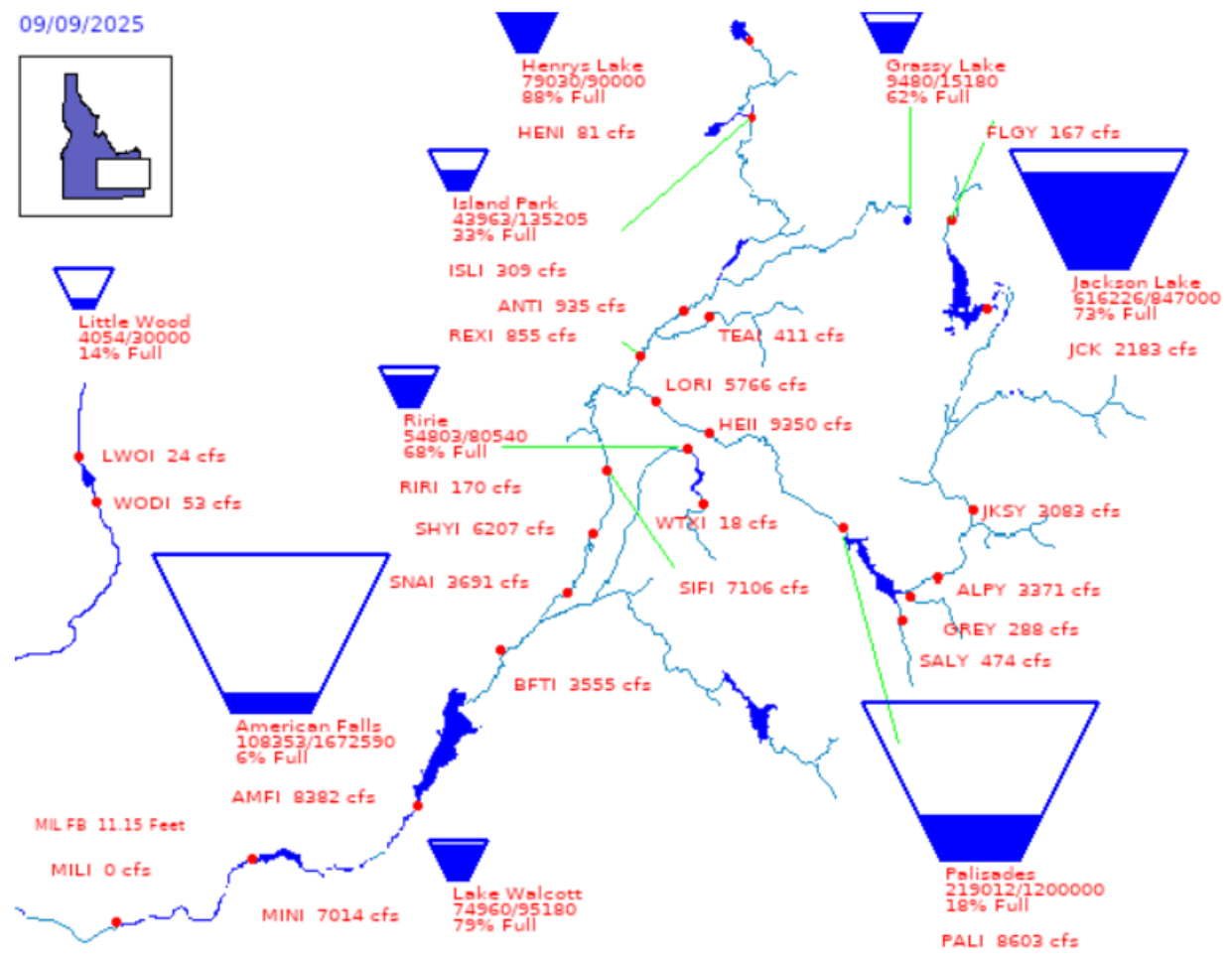

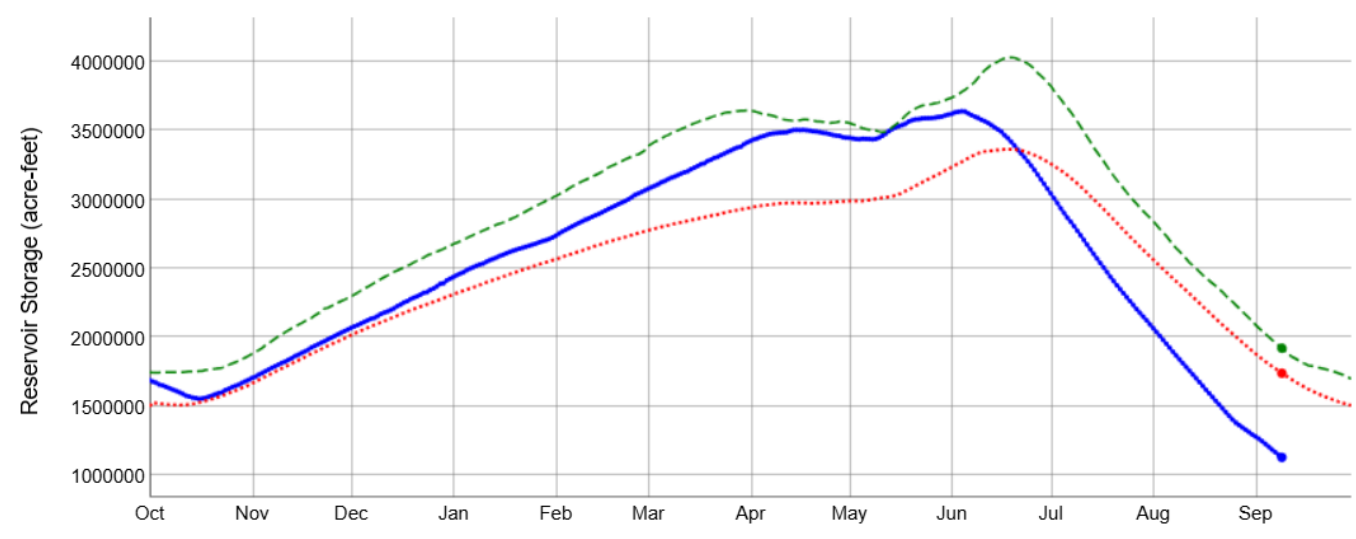

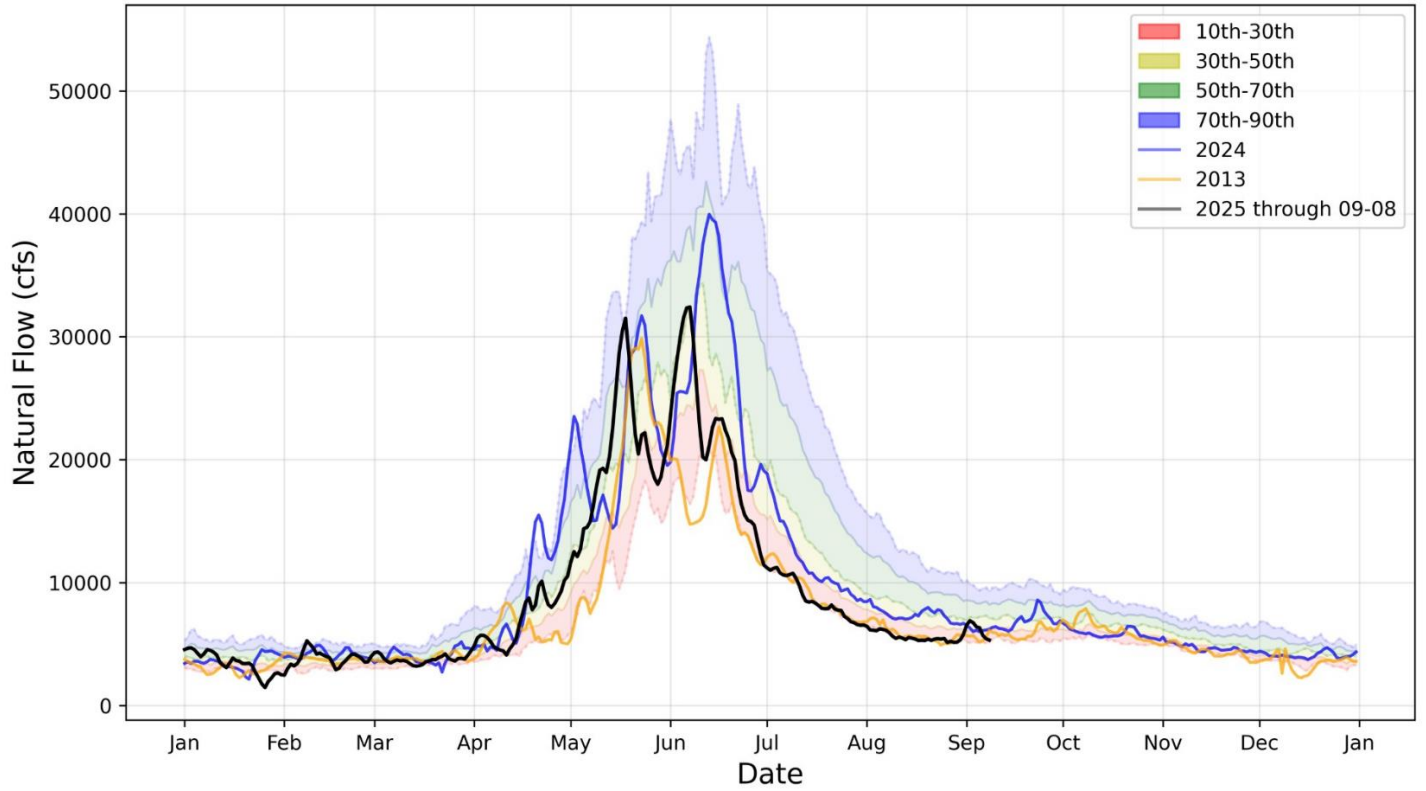

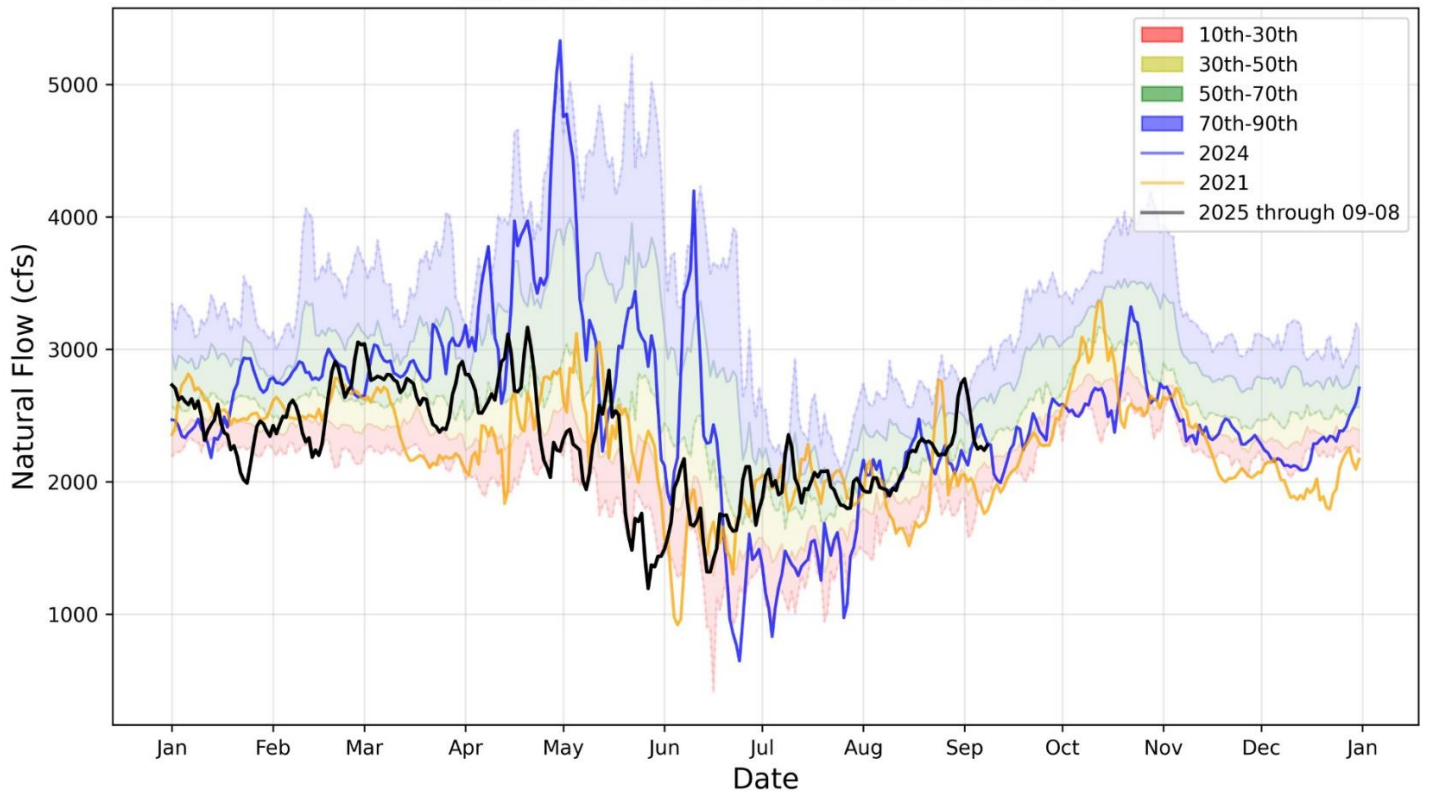
