

Water District 1 Report – September 17th, 2026

Natural flow Above Blackfoot has continued to decline gradually and is currently approximately 5,000 cfs. Diversions Above Blackfoot have also trended downward, likely due to crop timing and dwindling storage supplies, and are currently approximately 6,700 cfs. Several operations have now exhausted their available storage water. Water right priorities have generally remained near the 1889 level.

From September 6 through September 12, the priority for the Snake River Above Lorenzo separated from the downstream Snake River priority and moved to a more senior date as upstream senior priority diversions consumed all available natural flow. A USGS discharge measurement taken at Lorenzo on September 11 confirmed that the priority split reflected actual river conditions. The priorities reconnected on September 13 and are currently connected. During most of the separation, the priority Above Lorenzo was at the 1888 level.

Natural flow Below Blackfoot has remained relatively steady at approximately 1,800 cfs. Diversions have declined by roughly 700 cfs and are currently approximately 6,000 cfs.

The physical reservoir system is currently at approximately 10 percent of capacity and is projected to reach its lowest combined storage level since Ririe Reservoir was constructed. This extreme drawdown is placing significant operational strain on the system and requiring difficult decisions regarding the management of the remaining contents in individual reservoirs.

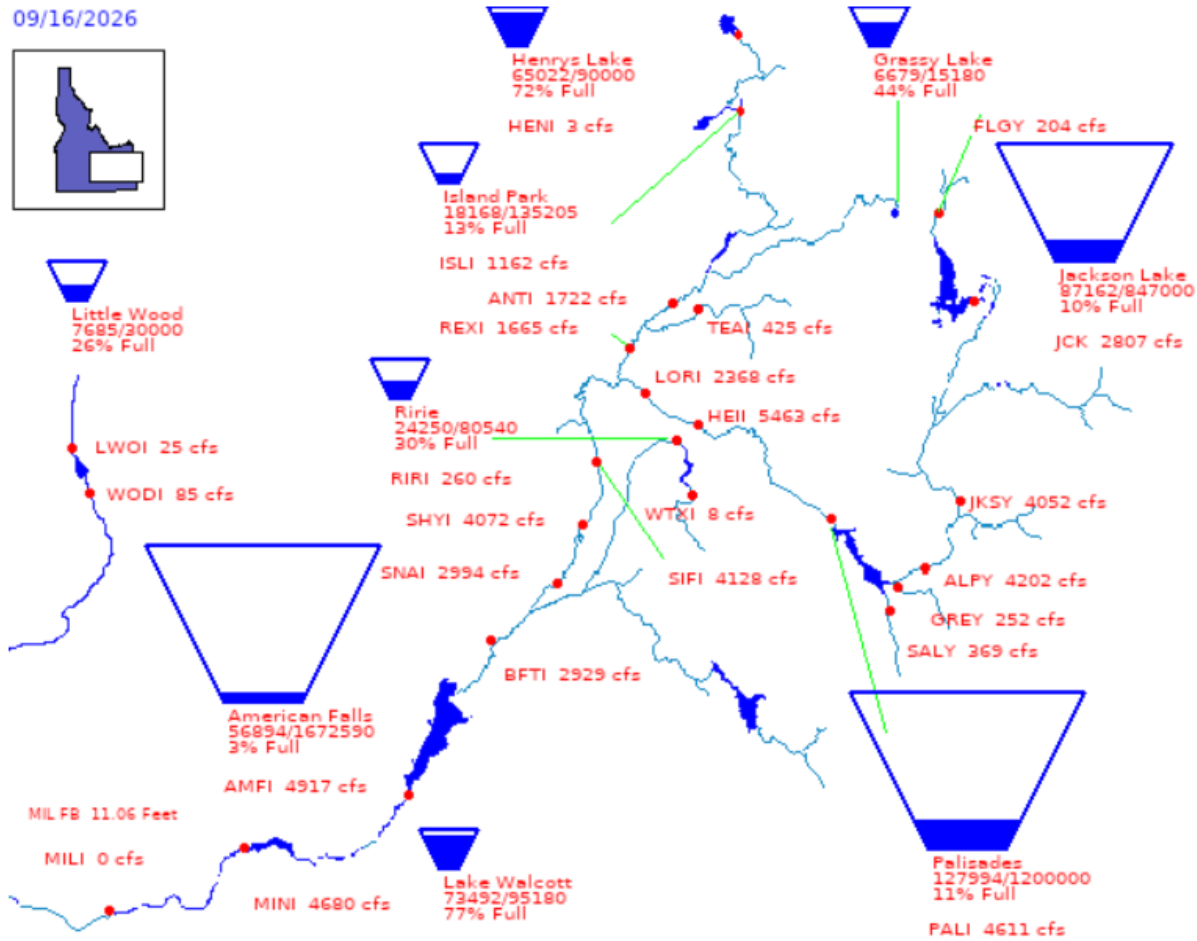

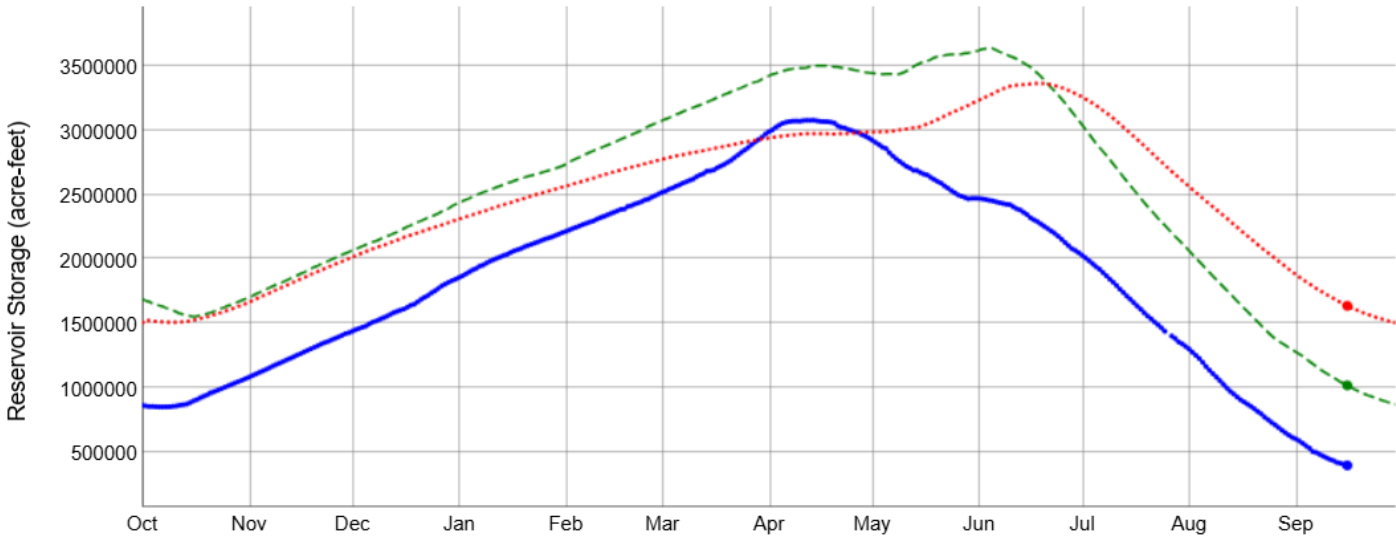

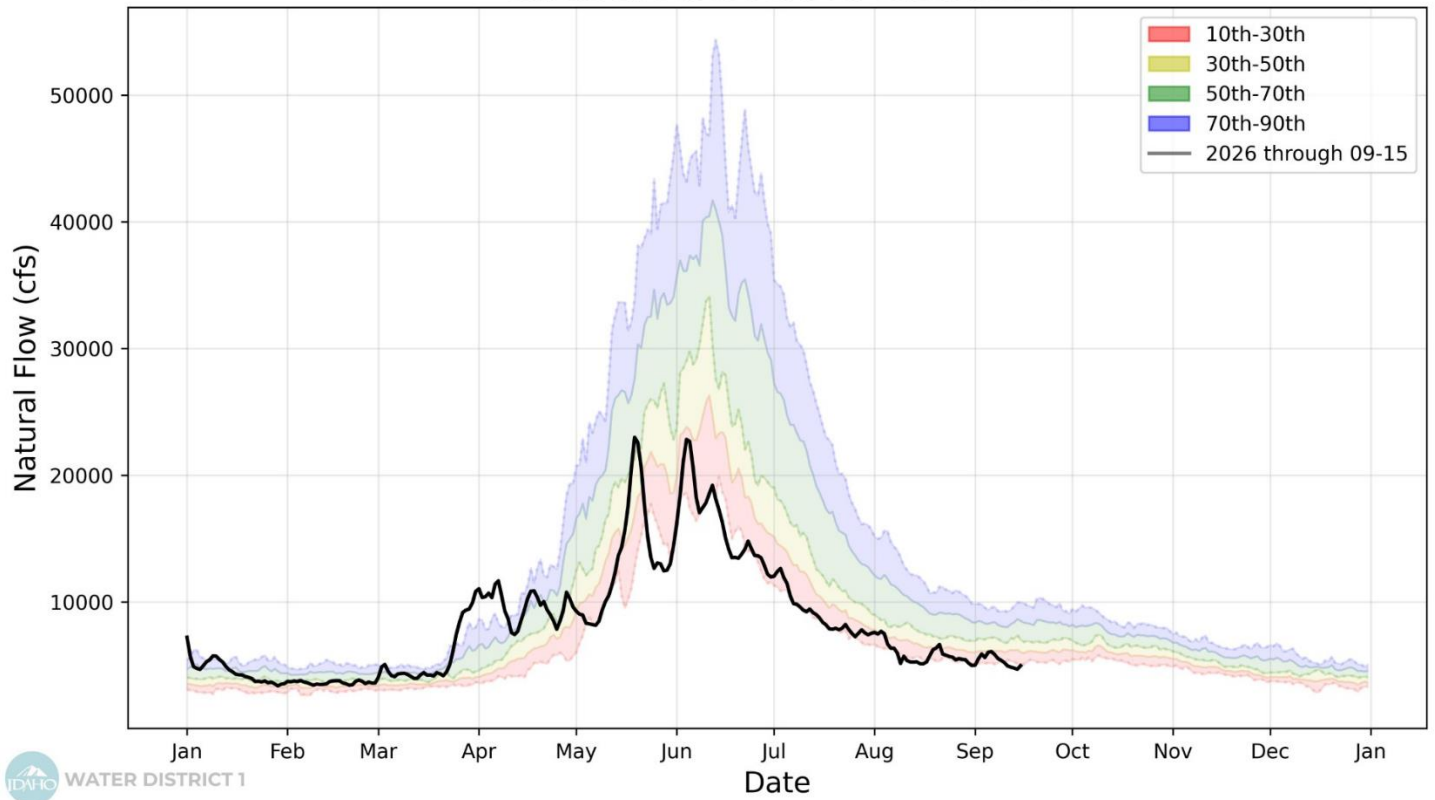

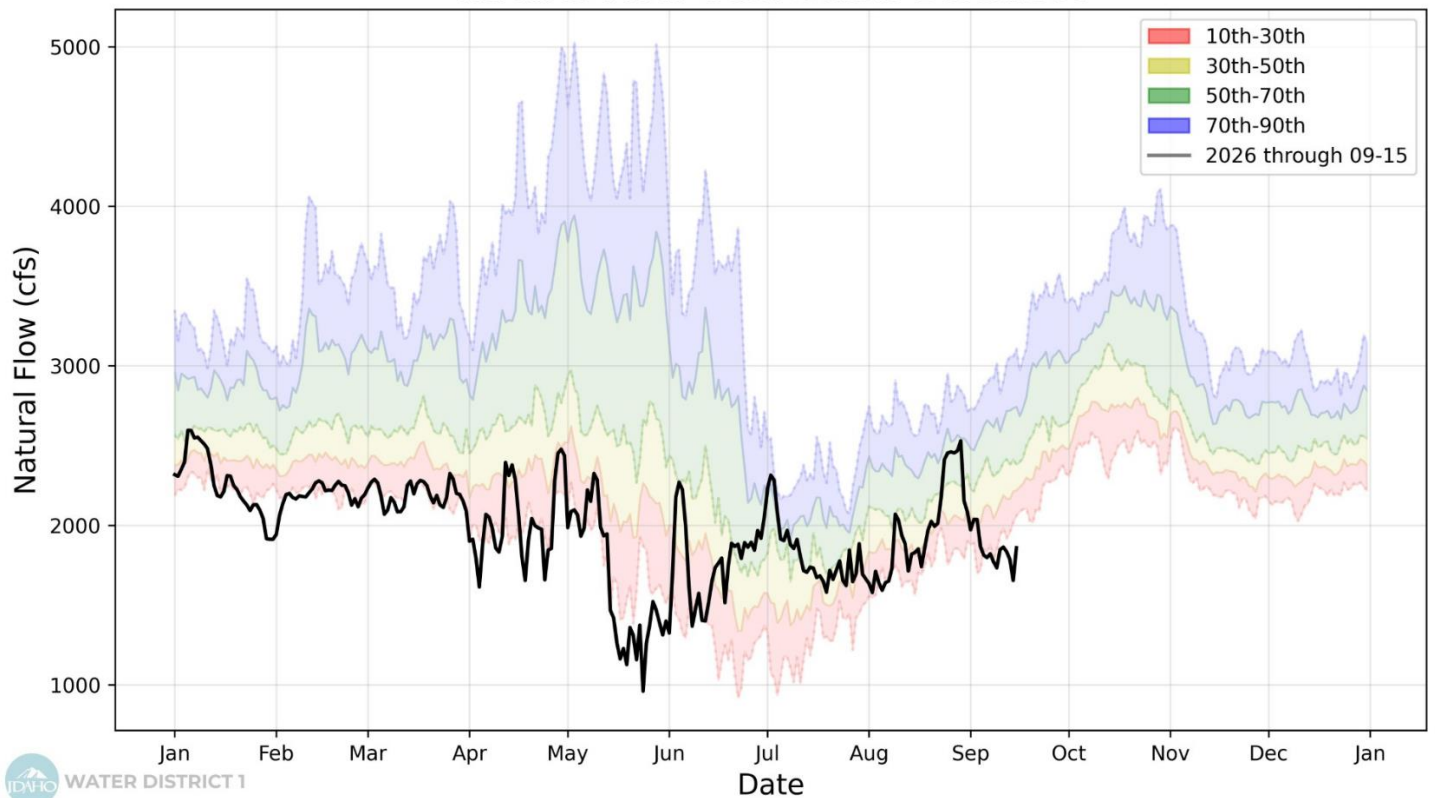
