

Water District 1 Report – August 19th, 2026

Rainfall received across the basin over the weekend temporarily increased natural flow deliveries and resulted in a corresponding shift toward more junior water-right priorities. Following the conclusion of the storm and the return of dry conditions, natural flow gains have begun to decline, with water-right priorities trending back toward more senior dates. Priorities are expected to return to approximately the 1888-1889 range as the effects of the recent precipitation diminish.

From a historical perspective, natural flow conditions above Blackfoot remain very poor, consistently ranking near or below the 10th percentile of the past 30 years. Only 2001 and 2007 were clearly lower during comparable periods, and conditions may be approaching those levels. Water District 1 is currently using 2025 as the analog year in the attached priority comparison and will continue monitoring whether conditions remain aligned with that year or begin trending toward other analogs.

Below Blackfoot, natural flow has also remained low over the past several weeks, generally ranging between the 10th and 30th percentiles of the past 30 years. Water District 1 has changed the analog year for this reach to 2004, as reach gains over the past month have more closely resembled conditions observed that year.

The projected water-right priorities for tomorrow are:

Falls River:	June 1, 1889
Henry's Fork:	June 1, 1889
Teton River:	June 1, 1885
Teton Lower North Fork:	October 17, 1885
Snake River above Lorenzo:	June 1, 1889
Snake River from Lorenzo to Blackfoot:	June 1, 1889
Snake River below Blackfoot:	October 11, 1900

The physical reservoir system continues to draft as natural flow supplies remain low and crop water demand persists. Physical system storage levels are tracking near several of the lowest water years experienced during the past 30 years.

Increased drafting from Ririe Reservoir began Monday, August 10 and continues, at approximately 700 acre-feet per day. These releases are being used to help manage the overall system draft and facilitate irrigation storage deliveries.

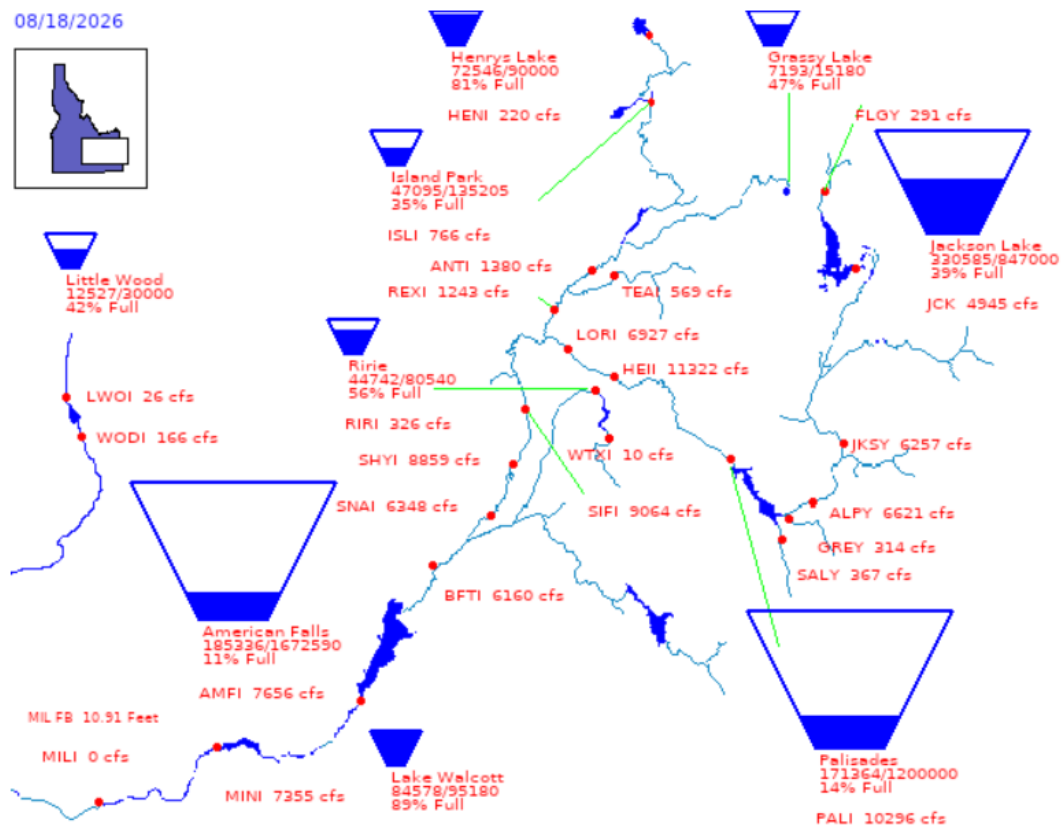

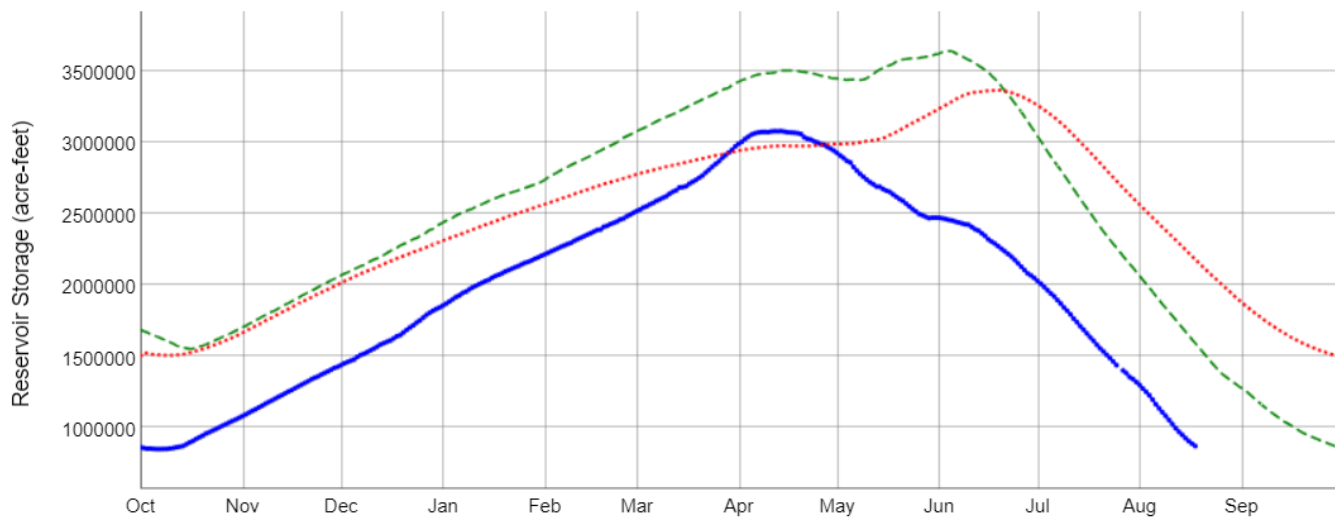

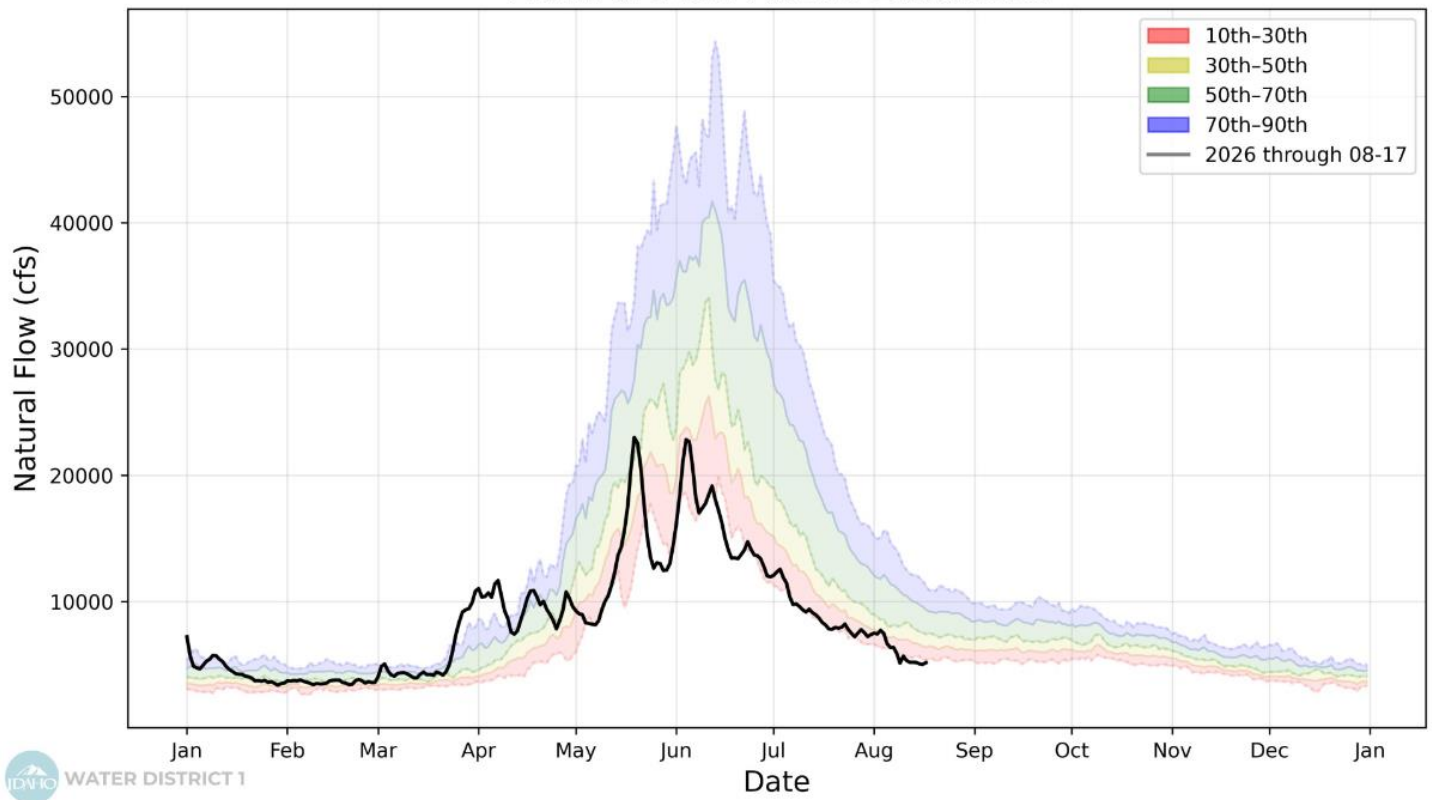

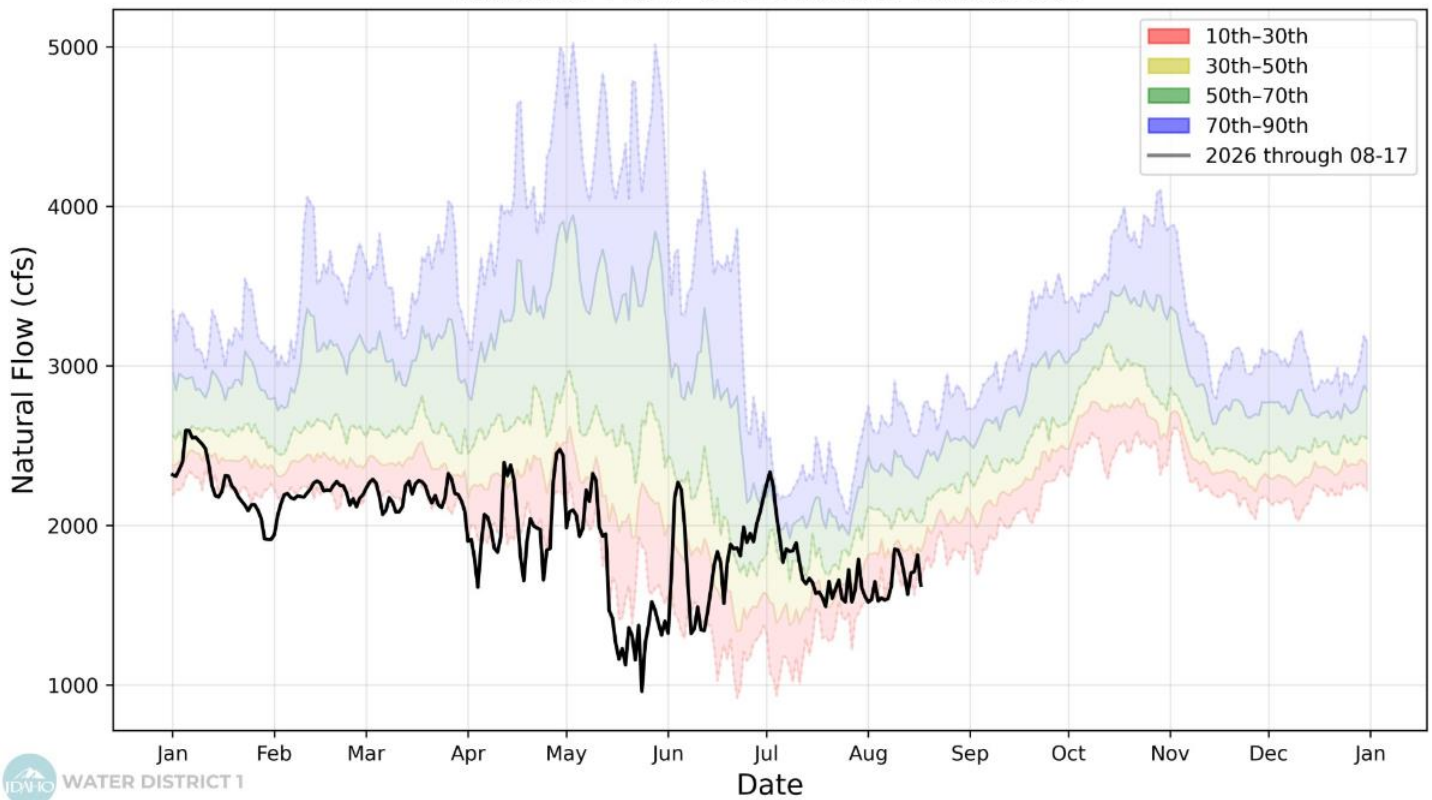
