

Water District 1 Report – October 9th, 2025

Diversion demand continues to decrease as canals shut off for the season. Forecasts indicate a continuation of cooler and wetter weather patterns, which may influence diversions. Natural flow conditions continue to remain steady across the basin. Water right priorities continue to rise, marking the seasonal transition from irrigation demand to system refill.

The Upper Snake River system is currently at roughly 850,000 acre-feet, or 21% of capacity – well below the average at just 61% of average. Over the past 30 years, only seven years have recorded lower carryover, four of which occurred in the early 2000s. Water District 1 anticipates about another week of reservoir draft before the system transitions to filling. Looking ahead, an above-average snowpack will be necessary to fully refill the system next year.

WD1 is projecting a partial water right fill of the following priorities for tomorrow, October 10th:

1900-10-11 Henry's Fork

1900-10-11 Fall River

1900-10-11 Teton River Above Island Ward Canal

1900-10-11 Teton River Lower North Fork

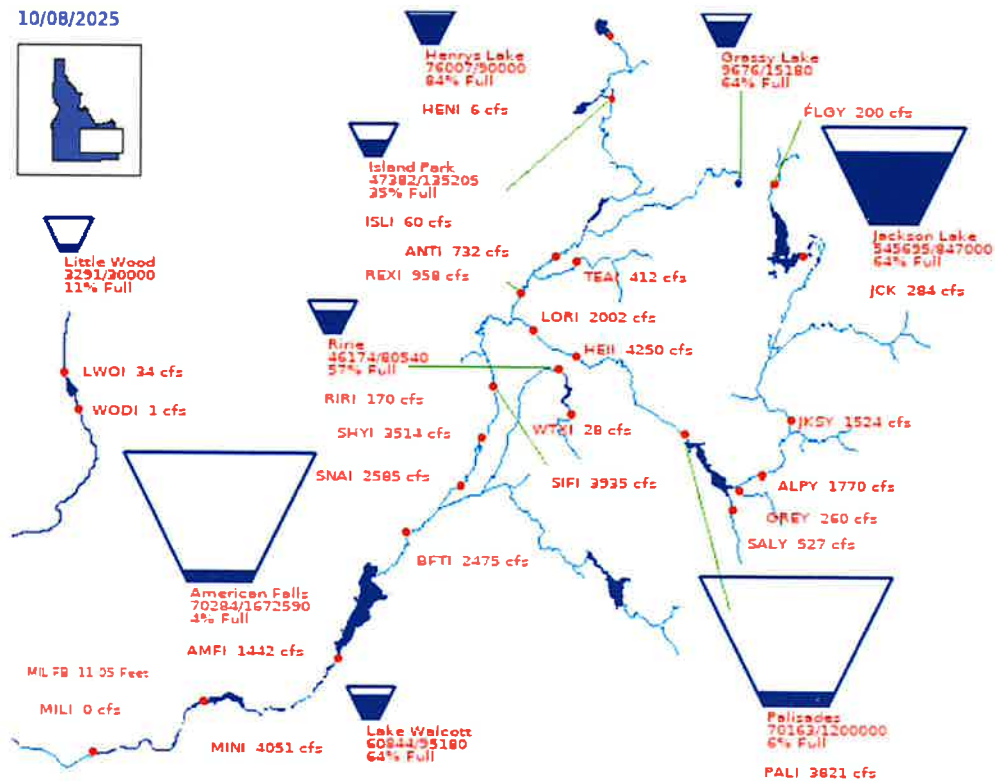
1900-10-11 Snake River Above Lorenzo

1900-10-11 Snake River below Blackfoot

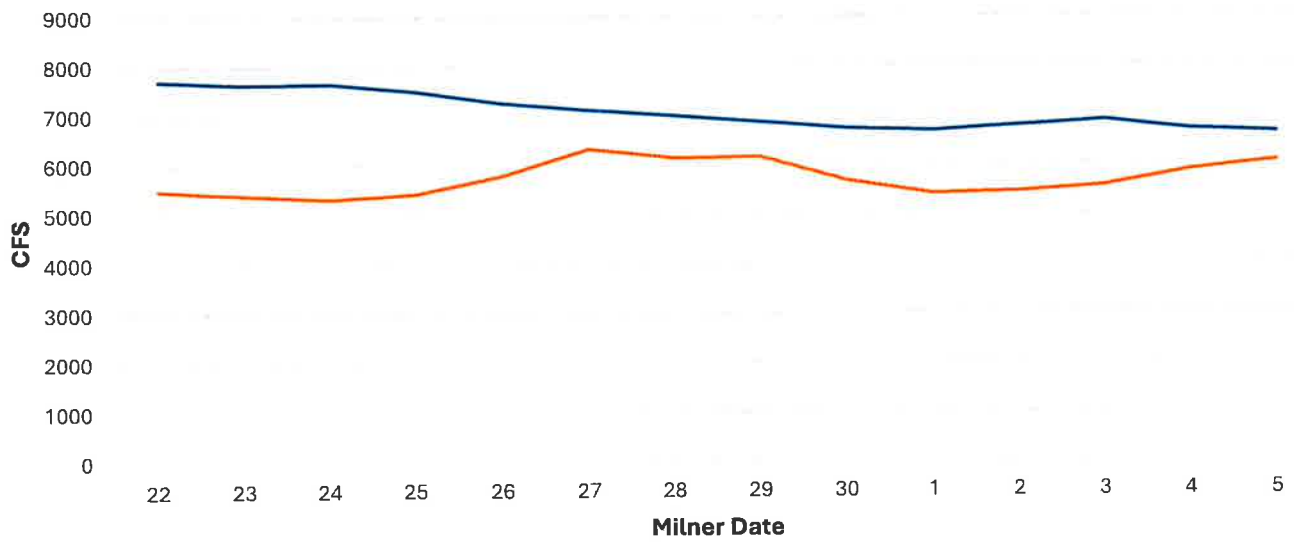

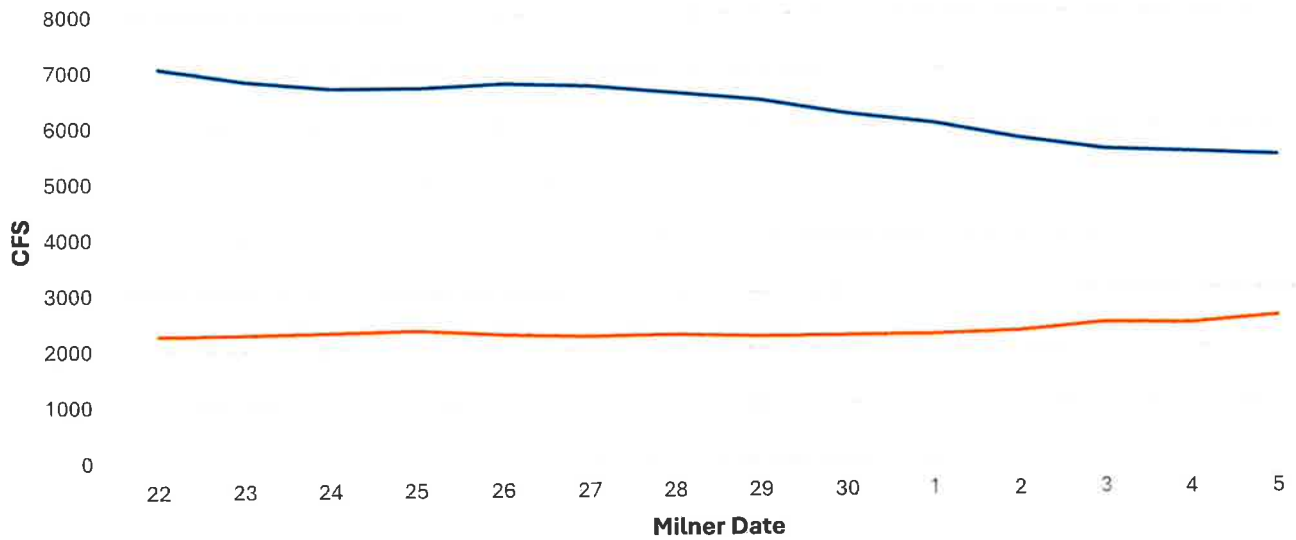

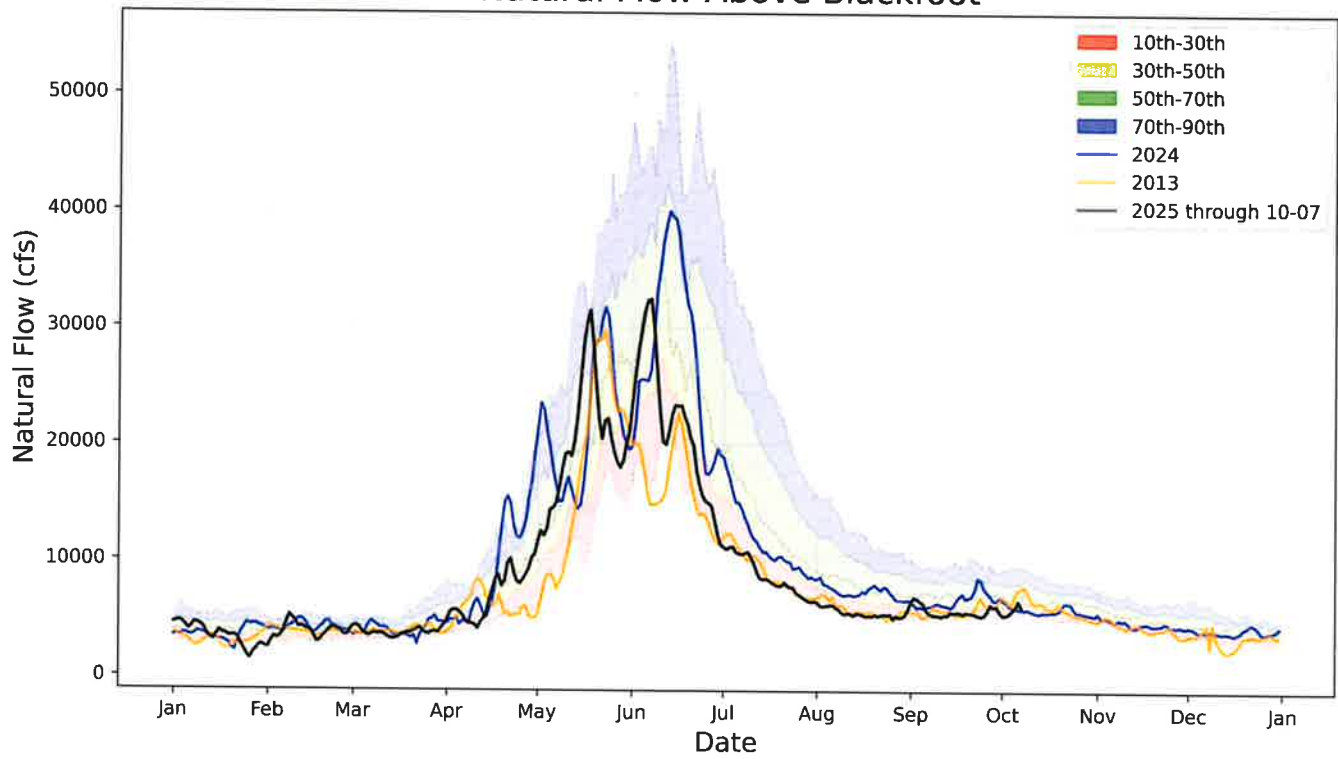
Above Blackfoot Gains vs Above Blackfoot Diversions



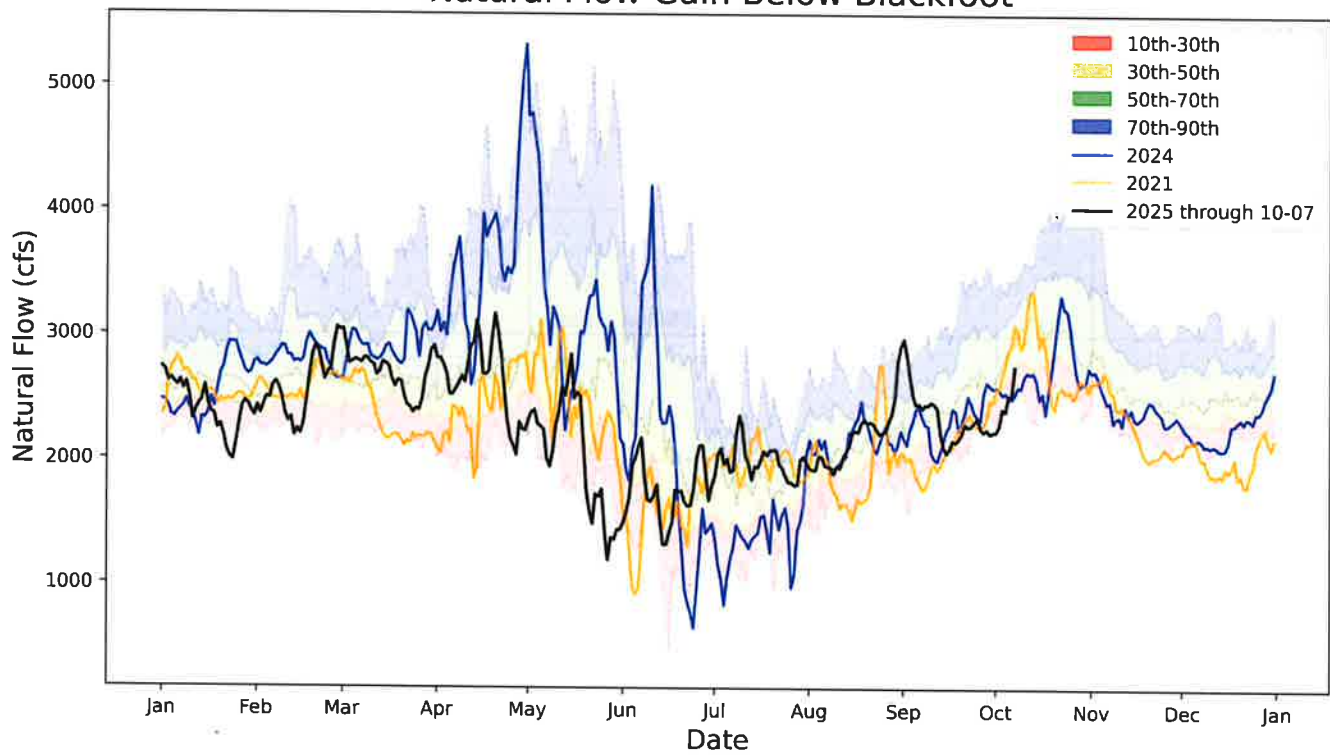
Below Blackfoot Gains vs Below Blackfoot Diversions
